Faculty of Medicine Universitas Airlangga has contributed significantly to the pandemic handling in Indonesia, such as from Marco-19 with Ksatria Airlangga Floating Hospital (RSTKA) on Madurese Isles, Covid-19 patients' handling in Indrapura Field Hospital, to vaccination services given to more than 80 thousands of people.



For its community services, Faculty of Medicine has achieved The Indonesian World Records Museum (MURI) record for the most COVID-19 vaccinations conducted by students. The faculty was also awarded another record for holding the most webinar sessions during the pandemic, with more than 62 thousand participants from 65 countries.

Its support for pandemic recovery has been shown by organizing regular second booster shot vaccination programs for medical workers. As an innovation in providing service to the community, Faculty of Medicine has initiated Dokter UNAIR TV to give education unlimited by time and distance.

Internationally, Faculty of Medicine Universitas Airlangga has produced competent doctors with great dedication. In the field of education and research, findings and innovations are continuously introduced by its academics.

The learning facilities offered by Faculty of Medicine include Graha BIK-IPTEKDOK; auditoriums, medical training space, Computer and English lab; and a problem-based learning discussion room. 

The Faculty of Dental Medicine (FKG) Universitas Airlangga is the oldest faculty of dental medicine in Indonesia. Founded in 1928, the faculty has changed names several times, from School Tot Opleiding van Indische Tandartsen (STOVIT), Ika Daigaku Shika, to Universiteit Tandheelkundig Instituut. As a pioneer of dental medicine in Indonesia, the Faculty of Dental Medicine has been at the forefront in achievement, quality of education, and facilities.

Various innovations and internationally indexed studies have contributed to enriching dentistry scientific studies. Apart from that, the Faculty of Dental Medicine has also produced the best dental medicine practitioner in the country.

The studies focus on critical thinking, time management, and leadership skills. The results are shown through many faculty academics who have made it to the top ranks in dental medicine organizations and various achievements.

The faculty believes that dental medicine aims to serve the country. Thus, they consistently prioritize community service activities to improve the health and welfare of the community.

The Faculty of Dental Medicine provides Dental Hospital (RSGM) Universitas Airlangga as a learning center, allowing students to experience laboratory activities and real-life practice. Besides, the Dental Research Center also helps increase published research in international journals.



The quality of research and performance shown in the publication of legal scientific papers also ranked first place in Indonesia by the 2022 Scimago Institutions Rankings (SIR) version. 

The Faculty of Economics and Business Universitas Airlangga has a long history as an educational institution since 1954. The faculty is committed to providing the best quality of education for the graduates. The learning system is designed and monitored through Airlangga Integrated Management System (AIMS), which has received quality recognition under ISO 9001: 2008, IWA 2: 2007, Malcolm Baldrige, National Accreditation Board for Higher Education (BAN-PT). Thirteen programs have been accredited by the Alliance On Business Education and Scholarship for Tomorrow, a 21st Century Organization (ABEST21), and obtained international certification from the ASEAN University Network (AUN).

The Faculty of Pharmacy is well-known for its excellence in research with several research fields, including the field of Pharmaceutical Engineering and Processing, Pharmaceutical Analysis Development, Natural Products, INACORE, Drug Development, and Clinical Pharmacy. Research and development of nature-based medicines are one of the faculty's specialties.

As one of the best pharmaceutical faculties in Indonesia, the Faculty of Pharmacy also has formulated dozens of innovative products for the community. Some of them are healthy drinks from green tea extract called "Meditea", male birth control pills in the form of "Gendarussa Extract Capsules", cholesterol-lowering herbal medicine called "Pro-Slimpid Capsules", anti-cancer herbal medicine called "Pro-Ca Capsules", anti-acne gel called "Muntingia Gel", and "You-Ka Cream" anti-aging cream.

The latest products are "Piperona" hand sanitizer, "Allset" hand sanitizer, and "Allset" surface sanitizer disinfectant.

The Faculty of Pharmacy is located at Campus MERR (C) Universitas Airlangga in an 11-floor building. Several facilities include Clinical Pharmacy Lab, Formulation Prescription Lab, Pharmaceutical Technology Lab, Synthetic Pharmacy Lab, Medicinal Chemistry Lab, MMI, Biotechnology Lab, Photochemistry Lab, Botany Lab, and Dry Laboratory (CBT & OSCE Center).

The Faculty of Pharmacy continues collaborating with universities and institutions at national and international levels. Most recently, collaborations have been established with Queen's University Belfast for Joint Research & Student Mobility, Leiden University for Joint Research Cooperation, and King's College London for academic cooperation.

Furthermore, the faculty also has a double degree program with Management & Science University Malaysia and an international student program through the International Undergraduate Program Faculty of Pharmacy UNAIR.

Faculty of Veterinary Medicine (FKH) Universitas Airlangga aims to provide education in General Professional Qualifications in the field of Veterinary Medicine. The graduates are expected to master the fields of Animal Health, Animal Production, and Veterinary Public Health.



The education system's quality is assured by Airlangga Integrated Management System (AIMS), which refers to the standards of ISO 9001:2015, MBNQA 2015-2016, and IWA2:2007. It is also certified by ASIIN, ASEAN University Network (AUN), IKTIRAF Malaysia, and LAM-PTKES. In addition, several laboratories have also been certified by KAN and FAO.

During foot and mouth disease (FMD), FKH swiftly went to livestock-producing areas to conduct outreach. FMD is not a deadly plague if appropriately handled. This assistance helps breeders to understand several ways of handling and anticipating FMD, which in turn overcomes the loss of livestock deaths.

Due to their dedication and knowledge, the government trusts FKH to analyze animal diseases. Students also often conduct education and outreach regarding the beneficial content of animal fats. Students occasionally distribute eggs and milk to the community while reminding the importance of the nutritional content of these animal-based products.

FKH UNAIR has an Animal Teaching Hospital (RSHP), Teaching Farm, and Veterinary Testing and Feed Analysis Unit with KAN accreditation, animal feed laboratory, bacteriology and mycology laboratory, virology laboratory, veterinary pathology laboratory, clinical laboratory, veterinary parasitology laboratory, and veterinary public health laboratory.

The faculty also offers other facilities in Kedamean, Gresik, including Educational Animal Park or Teaching Farm, and Veterinary Testing and Feed Analysis Unit (UPVETAP).

Amid the Covid-19 pandemic, FKH UNAIR has been continuously playing a role in helping the broader community through research and community service programs, such as Making Non-Alcohol Hand Sanitizer in several regions in Indonesia. Besides, several academic staff participated in the "Merah Putih" (Red White) vaccine research development.

FKH UNAIR's latest collaborations include joint research with Asia University, Taiwan; Faculty of Veterinary Science Chulalongkorn University; College of Veterinary Medicine, Tarlac Agricultural University; and Joint Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, Kagoshima University, Japan.

The Faculty of Social and Political Sciences (FISIP) Universitas Airlangga was first known as the Faculty of Social Science with Sociology as its first major. As time goes by, FISIP has grown into seven undergraduate programs, five post-graduate programs, and a doctoral program.

FISIP consistently improves its quality and capacity, strengthening its global credentials. While five majors have gained FIBAA international accreditation, the Sociology major is successfully listed in the 251-300 World rank according to QS WUR 2022 by Subjects. The achievements bring FISIP to the third rank on a national scale.

Beyond written and theoretical knowledge, FISIP develops its education system distinctively. The feature encourages FISIP to create knowledgeable and high-quality alums with a sense of humanity and empathy.

FISIP alumni have occupied strategic positions. National media agencies often refer to professors' and lecturers' opinions to respond to the current phenomena.

FISIP provides excellent learning facilities, such as the library, podcast room, Museum and Center for Ethnographic Studies, Integrated Communication Laboratory, Mini Theatre, and Cakra Laboratory (simulation laboratory).

During the COVID-19 pandemic, FISIP provides social assistance for the administrative staff and lecturers in quarantine, treatment, and financially support students from low-income families. Information about updates, services, and essential pandemic services is available on the website.

FISIP has established international collaborations. The latest partnership was formed with the Nanyang Technological University, Universiti Sultan Zainal Abidin, and Universiti Malaysia Terengganu. Some students have also participated in international short courses through various faculty programs.

Faculty of Science and Technology (FST) was the development of Basic Natural Science Institute under the management of Faculty of Medicine (FK). It developed into the Faculty of Mathematics and Natural Sciences (FMIPA). On April 10, 2008, FMIPA changed its name to the Faculty of Science and Technology (FST) and established new undergraduate programs such as Information Systems, Biomedical Engineering, and Environmental Engineering.

FST aspires to guide the development of science and technology, participating in the scientific community development and upholding the moral and eco-conscious community. FST produces graduates with high critical-analytical thinking skills, competitive, and innovative in creating valuable solutions for the community's welfare.

One of the lecturers and researchers at FST UNAIR was listed in the 2 percent of the world's most influential scientists in 2021. Students also contribute to developing practical innovations for the community.

In handling the pandemic, FST makes real contributions to the community through various research and product innovations. Some of them are Airlangga Robotic Triage Assistant (ARTA), which assists medical workers to check patients' temperature and conduct automatic anamnesis, and the Smart Washing Hand Machine (SWAM) as urban sanitation technology to maintain good hygiene. FST also builds disinfectant booths, makes face shields, and forms the FST Covid-19 task force team to help tackle the plague.

Currently, four majors at FST are accredited by AUN-QA and ASIIN. To support the learning process, FST provides academic facilities, such as mathematics laboratory, biology laboratory, chemistry laboratory, physics laboratory, faculty library, green yard, air-conditioned lecture halls, and UV light facility.

FST credentials in academic and non-academic field have significantly improved with their international academic partnerships. Recently, FST has collaborated with National Cheng Kung University Taiwan, University of Kitakyushu Japan, and National Taiwan University of Science and Technology.

Students can participate in international programs, such as the International Conference and Community Service Program. Most FST graduates become academics, practitioners, and lecturers at the national and international levels.



Faculty of Public Health (FKM) Universitas Airlangga is one of the pioneers of the Faculty of Public Health in Indonesia. The faculty has developed through sustainable and strategic planning. Therefore, academicians are expected to conduct research that supports the development of health science and technology for community service.



Excellent research, educational service, and community service, which impact the quality of life based on human resources and religious morality, produce proactive, innovative, and professional graduates. The FKM graduates have spread and served the community through government institutions and private companies. Some of them pursue their studies and professional growth overseas. It proves that FKM graduates are globally competitive.

Acknowledged internationally, FKM UNAIR is the first faculty in Southeast Asia to achieve international accreditation from the Agency for Public Health Education Accreditation (APHEA). FKM provides computer laboratories, epidemiology laboratory, health nutrition laboratory, Audio Visual Aid (AVA) laboratory, environmental health laboratory, and occupational health and safety laboratory to support the learning process.

FKM UNAIR has established national and international partnerships, including collaboration with the Ministry of Health in stunting countermeasures, the Health Office of East Lombok and Bima NTB for health program assistance, several hospitals in East Java as consultants, the collaboration of Geliat Airlangga and UNICEF, and grants from several institutions abroad such as Centers for Disease Control (CDC), World Health Organization (WHO), UNICEF, SATU Joint Research Scheme (JRS), and TIPH.

During the Covid-19 pandemic, FKM UNAIR has contributed significantly through its community service programs. FKM lecturers have been involved as consultants for the Covid-19 handling in the East Java Provincial Government. In 1983, the Psychology Program was established under the Faculty of Social and Political Sciences management and developed as a separate department in 1991. Two years later, the Faculty of Psychology was founded.

The Faculty of Psychology has proven to be one of the pioneers in developing psychology-based science and technology in accordance with religious morality in Indonesia. As a higher education institution, the Faculty of Psychology has been improving its quality to meet the demands of a continuously changing era. The development of modern, independent, and innovative education enhances the quality and competitiveness at the national and international levels.

In handling the pandemic, the Faculty of Psychology has made contributions by providing psychological assistance, such as free counseling services to the community, especially UNAIR academicians, who are affected by COVID-19. Besides, the faculty also gives mental and physical health education to working mothers during a pandemic through Instagram Live and actively collaborates with Psychology Student Association (HIMPSI) and the Presidential Staff Office in providing Covid-19 hotline service 119, ext 8. The service covers consultation, education, and psychological assistance for the wider community.

Faculty of Psychology Universitas Airlangga has partnered with global universities, like Monash University, Universiti Utara Malaysia, Lomonosov Moscow State University Russia, UNSW Australia, Management and Science University Malaysia, and Heinrich-Heine-Universität Düsseldorf, Germany. Established in 1954, Universitas Airlangga (UNAIR) initially had five faculties, including the Faculty of Letters in Denpasar, Bali. In 1962, the faculty declared its separation from Universitas Airlangga Surabaya. However, some UNAIR academicians were determined to re-establish the Faculty of Letters.

The culture, being an intellectual treasury that must be preserved and developed to maintain national identity, inspired the establishment of the Faculty of Letters. Besides, as a branch of knowledge, humanities are highly associated with science and technological transformation and application. The Faculty of Letters is expected to be one of Indonesia's cultural development centers.

However, students' growing interest in cultural studies for their thesis and the core of Literature and History studies which leaned to literature and culture encouraged the Faculty of Letters to change its name to Faculty of Humanities of Universitas Airlangga (State-Owned Legal Entity) according to the Rector's Decree No. 3292/J03/OT/2008 on April 10, 2008.

Faculty of Humanities has implemented online learning activities during the pandemic through the e-learning system. The activities were conducted in a room integrated with a platform for recording lectures and learning online using Zoom application.

Faculty of Humanities has various facilities to support the learning process, such as a library, multipurpose hall, Ferdinand de Saussure laboratory, Noam Chomsky laboratory, Teeuw laboratory. Poerwodarminto laboratory, history laboratory. computer laboratory, Kawabata Yasunari laboratory, Philology laboratory, gamelan (traditional Javanese music) room, music room, center, BIPA (Indonesian Language Program for Foreigners) room, archive center. Museum of History and Culture, and Self-Access Center Room for Japanese Studies.

Faculty of Humanities has also carried out international partnerships through student exchanges program at Asien African Institute, Universitat Hamburg, Germany; double degree program at Asia University Taiwan; visiting the archive center at KITLV Leiden, Netherlands; studying the Japanese culture at Iwata University, Nara University, and other leading universities across the world

The Faculty of Humanities also has a fast-track program, allowing students to accelerate their study time and gain the Bachelor of Humanities and Master of Humanities degrees at once.

Faculty of Nursing (FKp) Universitas Airlangga originated from the opening of the Nurse Educator Diploma IV (Four-year vocational) Program in November 1997 under the management of the Faculty of Medicine Universitas Airlangga (FK UNAIR). The Nursing Science -



Program (PSIK) establishment at the Faculty of Medicine resulted from a joint effort from the Ministry of Education and Culture, the Ministry of Health, and other related institutions with intensive workshops since 1998. In December 1997, a Nursing Working Group was formed in the Medical Science Consortium of FK UNAIR. On June 20, 2008, the Rector's Decree No. 5404/J03/OT/2008 declared that PSIK FK UNAIR changed its status to Faculty of Nursing (FKp).

FKp facilitates students to become professional nurses in terms of science (knowledge), attitude, and skills. It aims to create an image of a knowledgeable, open-minded, virtuous, and skillful nurse.

During the pandemic, FKp UNAIR contributed to the community by collaborating with the Surabaya Municipality to trace Covid-19 in Surabaya. It also sends nursing volunteers to the Indrapura Field Hospital and Covid-19 Referral Hospitals, contributes to the vaccination program in Surabaya, and conducts community service on Covid-19 transmission-based precautions in Surabaya.

To support the learning facilities, FKp provides various facilities, from the patient simulator for the critical nursing laboratory, tabletop disaster nursing, laboratory for basic human needs, nursing communi-

cation laboratory, maternal and child health nursing laboratory with a waiting room, reception desk, nurse station, acute care and emergency set facility. It also has patient rooms, isolation rooms, consulting room for patients and family, a patient dining room, a family counseling room, a group counseling therapy room (with audiovisual facility, playing, entertainment, reading, and singing), a playground, therapy room with the educational game sets, study space, and shelter for people with mental disorders by providing mental health nurse in Mojokerto.

For internationalization purposes, FKp conducts joint research and publication with various universities, such as National Cheng Kung University Taiwan, La Trobe University Australia, and Universiti Malaya Malaysia. FKp regularly holds international conference program featuring international speakers from Asia, Australia, and Europe.

Students can also participate in the faculty's internationalization programs, like Adjunct Professors (world-class professors) and webinar series under the framework of Airlangga Public Lecture Series with A+category speakers. FKp UNAIR has gained ASEAN University Network (AUN) Quality Assurance (QA) accreditation from various collaborative efforts and internationalization programs.

Faculty of Fisheries and Marine Sciences is responsible for the disciplines of fisheries and marine sciences. Universitas Airlangga established the Faculty of Fisheries and Marine Sciences (FPK) on July 25. 2008, according to the Rector's Decree Number 5887/JO3/OT/2008 as the 13th faculty. The faculty was developed from the aquaculture program under the auspices of the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine (FKH) UNAIR.

All FPK study programs have been nationally accredited through BAN-PT. FPK has also obtained international standardization certificates such as ISO (International Organization for Standardization), IWA (International Workshop Agreement), and Malcolm Baldrige.

FPK offers various learning facilities to support student's academic development, from the library, microbiology and fish health laboratory, wet laboratory, chemical laboratory, and educational fish pond.

FPK provides 6 competence areas in the research field, including Fish Processing, Functional Food Technology, Fisheries Science, Food Biotechnology/Microbiology, Aquatic Biota Physiology, and Fisheries Natural Science. In the community service field, FPK has conducted 17 village empowerment in Sumenep, Sidoarjo, Surabaya, and Banyuwangi.

Currently, FPK collaborates with national and international partners. In the domestic range, FPK partners up with seven government institutions, including the Ministry of Marine Affairs and Fisheries (KKP), Office of Marine Affairs and Fisheries of East Java Province, Banyuwangi Regional Government, Office of Animal Husbandry and Fisheries of Blitar, Office of Fisheries of Pacitan, Office of Fisheries of Gorontalo, and Center for Fish Quarantine, Quality Control, and Safety of Fishery Products Surabaya II.

At the international scale, FPK partners up with nine institutions, including the ASEAN-Fisheries Education Network (ASEAN-FEN) as a Core Member; Graduate School of Biosphere Science, Hiroshima University; Nagasaki University; College of Fisheries Science – Pukyong National University; National Taiwan Ocean University; National Cheng Kung University; National Pingtung University of Science and Technology; National Kaohsiung University of Science and Technology; and Universiti Malaysia Terengganu.

Faculty of Vocational Studies (FV) at Universitas Airlangga offers vocational education. UNAIR established the FV on May 14, 2014, according to the Rector's Decree Number 1539/UN3/2014 as the 14th faculty. The establishment of this faculty was developed from the vocational programs, which eight UNAIR faculties had previously managed since 1984. Those faculties were the Faculty of Medicine (FK)), Faculty of Dental Medicine (FKG), Faculty of Public Health (FKM), Faculty of Veterinary Medicine (FKH), Faculty of Economics and Business (FEB), Faculty of Social and Political Sciences (FISIP), Faculty of Humanities (FIB), and Faculty of Science and Technology (FST).

All programs in the FV are nationally accredited by two institutions: the National Accreditation Body for Higher Education (BAN-PT) for non-medical programs and the Indonesian Health Higher Education Independent Accreditation Institute (LAMPT-KES) for medical programs.

FV provides banking laboratory facilities, marketing hospitality laboratories. laboratories. multimedia studios, and libraries.

FV has established 14 international programs: Malaysia-Indonesia Students (Ubiquitous Colloquium); Mabar (Melayu Berbudaya); (Community Health Improvement Programs); RCNs (Rural Community Nursing); BATTRA (Best Applied Traditional Treatment); LAC (Laboratory Animal Care); Physiotherapy Management for Prevention Work-Related Musculoskeletal Disorder; Fabrication of Feeding Obturator for Newborn Cleft Palate: Radiation Protection in Diagnostic Imaging, Interventional, and Nuclear Medicine; Advance Method on Laboratory Technology; Mass Gathering Risk Assessment During Pandemic; OSH Week; and Library Tour.

FTMM exists to complement the three pillars of science in Universitas Airlangga, social science, life science, and health science, with a new pillar, engineering.

In the field of research, the faculty has nine research groups: Food and Environmental Nanotechnology; Nanotechnology and Nanomedicine; Human Factors and System Engineering; Advanced Manufacturing and Computational Approach; Data-Driven Decision Support System, Robotics and Mechatronics; Digital Health, Computational Learning, Intelligent System; Renewable and Sustainable Energy Technology; and Intelligent Power and Control Engineering.

To support its research performance, the faculty has provided various equipment for research preparations, including analytical balance, ovens, furnaces, and analyzing equipment such as potentiostats, UV – Vis spectrophotometers, and optical microscopes.

During Covid-19 pandemic, FTMM has made technological innovations with some research partners. Some of its innovations are ISYANA, a disinfection spraying robot, Airlangga Robotic Triage Assistant (ARTA-1), a medical assistant robot for patients exposed to COVID-19.

In the field of technology, FTMM has made some innovations, such as an IoT-based Weather Station and Automatic Calibrator for Limit Switch Control Valve on geothermal power plants.

It was an off-campus program situated in Banyuwangi Regency. The establishment of the program was based on the request of Banyuwangi Regency government in the letter of General Directorate of Higher Education No. 276/E.E2/DT/2014 about the mandate of PSDKU UNAIR programs establishment in Banyuwangi. The program - was established from a continuous partnership between Universitas Airlangga and Banyuwangi Regency government in developing higher education in Banyuwangi.

On December 29, 2021, PSDKU Universitas Airlangga Banyuwangi changed its name to the School of Health and Natural Sciences (SIKIA) based on a decree by the Board of Trustees (MWA) Universitas Airlangga Number 6 in 2021. The academic activities in SIKIA are similar to those of faculties organizing and managing the educational process in specific education fields (based on the definition of school in the Statutes of Universitas Airlangga, Government Regulation (PP) Number 30 in 2014.

All programs are accredited by national agencies, BAN-PT for non-medical programs and LAMPT-KES for health programs.

SIKIA UNAIR in Banyuwangi has two campuses: Giri Kampus for the Aquaculture program and Veterinary Medicine program and Sobo Campus for Public Health program.

Some facilities supporting the education process in Banyuwangi include laboratories, libraries, halls, and student organization centers. Student leadership and organizational development are facilitated through UNAIR Banyuwangi Student Family, Student Association (HIMA), interest and talent communities, and Semi-autonomous Board (BSO) to improve the students' soft skills.

SIKIA UNAIR has contributed significantly to achieving Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). SIKIA has established collaborative research specifically designed to support SDGs, such as with external partners and the faculty on the main campus. In the community services field, some of the activities to support SDG 3: Good Health and Wellbeing achievement are conducted through the conservation of rare medicinal plants, dissemination of urinary incontinence to the elderly and hypertension prevention, and development of Kepiting program to address stunting issues.

Universitas Airlangga has been entrusted with managing two regional higher education institutions: Gresik Nursing Academy and Lamongan Nursing Academy. The delegation management agreement was signed at the AMERTA Hall Campus MERR (C) Universitas Airlangga at the end of 2017.

The transfer of responsibility from the Gresik and Lamongan Regency governments was started on January 1, 2018. The institution merger was ratified on January 2, 2018, based on the Rector's Decree Number 63/UN3/2018. Hence, Gresik Nursing Academy and Lamongan Nursing Academy have officially become the Three Year Vocational Nursing Program of Universitas Airlangga in Gresik and Lamongan.

Through the Student Admission Center (PPMB), the three-year vocational Nursing Program Faculty of Vocational Studies (FV) Universitas Airlangga in Gresik and Lamongan accepted 220 new students in the 2018/2019 academic year. The programs in Gresik and Lamongan campuses provide 14 permanent lecturers from the previous Nursing Academy, 14 lecturers from the Nursing Faculty (FKp), and other experts, including the support of 25 administrative staff.

The campus also provides basic nursing laboratory, mental and community laboratory, mini-hospital, laboratory warehouses, maternity nursing laboratory, reading rooms, and other supporting facilities. The graduates are encouraged to become skilled nurses in solving nursing problems independently and in groups according to the nursing care standards. As qualified nurses, graduates also play the role of communicators, providers, managers of nursing care, and research assistants.

In the field of research, collaborative research between lecturers and students were conducted. In 2020, several research received funding, some of them being "Determinants and Impacts of Ethical Behavior in Nursing Care and Nurse Caring Behavior on Patient Satisfaction" and "High-Risk Pregnant Women's Experiences in Hospital Antenatal Care".









Universitas Airlangga established the Postgraduate School (SPS) based on the Decree of the Rector of Universitas Airlangga Number 2444 / PT03.H/E/1992. This institution is a development of the postgraduate program, which was previously known as the Postgraduate Faculty.



The programs have gained national and international accreditations. The national accreditations include the National Accreditation Board for Higher Education (BAN-PT) for non-health programs and LAMPT-Kes for health programs. Some programs have also been accredited by Asia Forensic Sciences Network (AFSN) and the Alliance on Business Education and Scholarship for Tomorrow (ABEST 21).

The Postgraduate School of Universitas Airlangga offers Executive Learning Hub (ELH) non-degree program under the Postgraduate School Director. The program allows executives, directors, and managers in companies to upgrade their knowledge through training activities or short courses about Business, Management, Law, Data Science, and Scientific Article Publications.

In the field of research, Postgraduate School Universitas Airlangga provides five research study centers; Center of Good Governance and Bureaucracy Reform; Center for Women Empowerment in Law Enforcement; Center of Civil Society; Center of Environmental and Sustainable Energy; and Center of Creative Industry.

In the field of educational development, Postgraduate School actively collaborates with international researchers in the form of guest professors, international lecture, and visiting professors, including international conference activities and Online Summer School.







Universitas Airlangga has three libraries, one on each campus (Campus Dharmahusada A, Campus Dharmawangsa B, and Campus MERR C), and the main library is located in Campus Dharmawangsa B. HOSPITAL

Universitas Airlangga started its Teaching Hospital construction at the end of 2007. The establishment was based on the strong desire to serve the country through health development aligns with Universitas Airlangga's vision and mission.

At the end of 2010, Universitas Airlangga Teaching Hospital completed the macro construction of the 8-floor building, although only a few floors were micro-operable. In early 2011, the Rector's Decree was issued regarding the appointment of the Head of Universitas Airlangga Teaching Hospital. Since then, intensive and integrated activities have been carried out to prepare for the opening of Universitas Airlangga Teaching Hospital around June 2011.

On March 9, 2011, a Permit Approval from the Head of the Surabaya Municipal Health Service was issued regarding the establishment of Universitas Airlangga Teaching Hospital and the temporary permit to operate the hospital. Thereafter, the name of the Universitas Airlangga Teaching Hospital was changed to Universitas Airlangga Hospital.

With the Permit Approval from the Head of the Surabaya City Health Office, the promotion of Universitas Airlangga Teaching Hospital and patient service simulations were carried out with satisfactory results. Therefore, June 14, 2011, was marked as the day of "Inauguration of Universitas Airlangga Hospital in the Early Stage (Soft Opening)".

The government has appointed Universitas Airlangga Hospital (UNAIR Hospital) to conduct a pilot project for teaching hospitals in Indonesia. UNAIR Hospital, providing health services to the Health Care and Social Security Agency (BPJS Kesehatan) patients, offers qualified resources, services, and facilities.

Beyond medical services, UNAIR Hospital also carries out programs for the elderly, research visits, free cataract surgery, and many more. In 2015, UNAIR Hospital was selected as the Most Trusted Hospital and Quality Service of The Year.

As a teaching hospital, UNAIR Hospital provides supporting facilities for educational activities such as lecture rooms, study rooms, Medical Specialist Education Program (PPDS) rooms, discussion rooms, resident rooms, and research ethics rooms.

Excellent services are provided through the Geriatric Clinic, Airlangga Aesthetic Center, Surabaya Neurosurgery Center, Varicose Clinic, Integrated Complementary Traditional Health Service Unit, Microtia Center, Integrated Oncology Clinic, and Center for Medical Integrated Digital Design Research as a collaboration unit with the Sepuluh Nopember Institute of Technology (ITS).

There are also hemodialysis units, inpatient care, ICU/ICCU/NICU/PICU, 26 specialist and subspecialist clinics, Medical Check Up, radiology and laboratory units, Home Care Units, and 24/7 Ambulance and Emergency Installation.

UNAIR Hospital, which has gained the highest accreditation from the Hospital Accreditation Commission (KARS) and international accreditation in 2019, is supported by 130 medical specialists, 27 general physicians and dentists, 1 general practitioner (structural and residency), 615 nurses and midwives, and other staff, reaching 1.047 in total.

During the pandemic, UNAIR Hospital has become one of the main referral hospitals for handling COVID-19. UNAIR Hospital actively provides health services for COVID-19 recovery. All elements of UNAIR Hospital, including human resources and supporting facilities, were provided to give the most effective medical services.

UNAIR Hospital and Telkom Surabaya Institute of Technology (IT Telkom) has collaborated to arrange a multifunctional Automated Health Examination Pavilion (APKM) to minimize contact transmission between medical personnel and patients.

UNAIR Hospital actively conducts research and innovation related to the health sectors and COVID-19 handling. Some innovations include the Integrated Digital Design Research Center for Medical (IDIG-RCMED) in collaboration with ITS, AIRBILISUN to detect and treat children with jaundice, the Self-Diagnosis Kiosk in collaboration with IT Telkom to save examination time 2 hours faster, and many more. In the IT field, Prof. Dr. Nasronudin stated that UNAIR Hospital has launched Si Perdana app with features like E-Registration, E-Medical Records, E-Laboratory, E-Radiology, and other services.

CARHA TRIMED

Tropical and infectious diseases in Indonesia remain highly concerning health issues. Not only due to the soaring morbidity and mortality rates, the diseases also widely impact the nation in terms of economy, politics, society, education, and security.

Numerous life-threatening, infectious diseases leading to disabilities such as HIV-AIDS, tuberculosis, malaria, dengue fever, hepatitis, leprosy, and diarrhea; and the epidemic diseases such as avian flu, swine flu, SARS, and the ones transmitted from animals (zoonosis) remain serious threats in Indonesia.

Recently, there have been many reports of changes in the microbiological, pathological, and epidemiological properties of microorganisms that cause the aforementioned diseases and the emergence of enormous kinds of drug resistance. Diseases that were once under control now reemerge with diverse variations like they are new.



This situation forces us to constantly, regularly, and conceptually conduct observations and research on various changes in the pattern of these dangerous infectious diseases. The fact that our people's socio-economic and education levels are still low forces us to seek solutions for the most effective and efficient ways of coping.

Until now, various ways to control and prevent tropical and infectious diseases are mostly driven by overseas research, which is different from real-life situations in the field. It prevents us from taking effective countermeasures and preventive actions.

Universitas Airlangga has long been aware of the problem. It was proven by the establishment of the Tropical Disease Research Center (TDRC), which later became TDC and ITD (LPT) in 1991, and Biosafety Level (BSL 3) as a vaccine manufacturing project for avian flu. In addition, Universitas Airlangga has been operating the Teaching Hospital.

For the achievements and capabilities of Universitas Airlangga experts, the Health Minister of the Republic of Indonesia agreed to build a Tropical and Infection Hospital in Campus MERR (C) of Universitas Airlangga. Developed in 2008, the hospital was expected to be the research center for tropical and infectious diseases with cutting-edge diagnostic tools and well-equipped laboratories.

However, the journey to becoming a research hospital is not easy due to the nonexistence of legislative regulations. Therefore, the hospital had to become a service hospital to get an operational permit. Thus, on December 1, 2015, the East Java Provincial Health Office issued an operational permit for the hospital under the name of UNAIR Special Hospital for Infectious Diseases. After running for a year, the management was merged with Universitas Airlangga Hospital. Hence, UNAIR Special Hospital for Infectious Disease changed its name to GRHA TRIMED of Universitas Airlangga Hospital. GRHA TRIMED offers excellent facilities to support patients' treatments for infectious diseases, like negative pressure rooms, HEPA filters, and so on. Various advanced diagnostic and laboratory tools have been used both for diagnostic and research activities.

GRHA TRIMED-Universitas Airlangga Hospital, ITD, BSL-3, and Education Hospital were expected to produce effective policies to cure and treat tropical and infectious diseases. Besides, the hospitals were also expected to be the center for national referral hospitals, clinical tests, and other biological innovations, like vaccines and herbal medicines.

GRHA TRIMED-RS UNAIR was expected to synergically collaborate with ITD and BSL-3 to be a Health Science Center facility of Universitas Airlangga. The synergy may become a referral source for solving various health problems, especially tropical and infectious diseases. It is a form of national responsibility, considering Indonesia is a tropical country with countless infectious diseases.





CADEMIC JENTAI HOSPITAL

UNIVERSITAS AIRLANGGA (RSGMP)

Academic Dental Hospital Universitas Airlangga (RSGMP) is a type B dental hospital with 24-hour Dental and Medical Emergency Installation (IGD). The RSGMP was established as a medical center, until now a Dental and Oral Teaching Hospital.

The dental hospital is equipped with excellent facilities. The inpatient care unit provides ten third-class beds, two second-class beds, one first-class bed, one VIP-class bed, and two child beds. While the outpatient services provide 169 dental chairs, the emergency dental services are equipped with one dental chair and three beds. Two units of beds are available in the intensive care unit (High Care Unit) with two large operating rooms (Central Surgery Installation), and two recovery rooms.

General practitioners are available in the Medical Emergency Installation with standard equipment. The general service department also cooperates with some units such as laboratory installation, radiology installation, and other related service units.

The essential dental services include basic dental examination, tartar cleaning, filling, nerve canal treatment, making dentures, children's dental care, oral and gum disease treatment, and tooth extraction.

VETERINARY TEACHING HOSPITAL

Veterinary Teaching Hospital (RSHP) is one of the prestigious units of Faculty of Veterinary Medicine (FKH) Universitas Airlangga. The hospital was established with a vision to be an excellent veterinary hospital with modern facilities and infrastructure, developing professional and competent human resources that uphold ethics, and achieving outstanding service quality, public trust, and satisfaction.

The four-story hospital is located on Campus MERR (C) UNAIR, right next to the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine on Jalan Dharmahusada Permai, Mulyorejo. The Veterinary Teaching Hospital was officially inaugurated by the Minister of Education, Culture, Research, and Technology, Muhammad Nasir on July 11, 2018.

The inauguration of Veterinary Teaching Hospital was added to the list of hospitals owned by Universitas Airlangga, including Universitas Airlangga Hospital (RSUA), which was inaugurated in 2011, and the Dental Hospital (RSGM) in 2016.

The inauguration also marks the effort in preparing qualified graduates. It is a part of UNAIR's mission towards a world-class university. The synergy between the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine and Veterinary Teaching Hospital aims to optimize their roles, especially in the learning and education aspects. The hospital is expected to improve the competencies of Faculty of Veterinary Medicine graduates.

The hospital is expected to expand the scope of veterinary healthcare and to be a referral hospital by vets, regional laboratory, and veterinary health center (Puskeswan) in East Java.

Veterinary Teaching Hospital of Universitas Airlangga is expected to perform three functions, including conducting veterinary education, research, and providing veterinary health services. This hospital is open for 24 hours, supported with adequate equipment and facilities to provide the best services, such as radiographic computers, ultrasonography, hematology analyzer, 3 operating rooms, and many more.

In the field of education, the hospital allows Veterinary Medicine students to study and practice through training or workshops. In the field of research, it has become a part of research conducted by the academic community, where they can perform preclinical tests from the findings on the medical device blueprint and newly formulated medicines for animals and humans.

ASEAN UNIVERSITY NETWORK (AUN) QUALITY ASSURANCE

AUN-QA (Quality Assurance) is one of ASEAN University Network activities to conduct quality assurance of programs organized by its members. AUN-QA performs a systematic, structured and continuous assessment of the member universities.

AUN-QA is an assessment, not an accreditation. The accreditation is a part of QA. The university member organizes a self-assessment by writing a SAR (Self-Assessment Report). The papers' completeness is then confirmed, and Action for Improvement is formulated from the result of SAR.

After that, a reviewer team of AUN members visits the university to assess and review the self-assessment report.

AUN-QA has certified 17 programs of Universitas Airlangga.

ASIIN

ASIIN, which stands for Accreditation Agency for Degree Programs in Engineering, Informatics/Computer Science, the Natural Sciences, and Mathematics, is a non-profit higher education accreditation organization from Germany acknowledged by international academic communities.

ASIIN offers accreditation for better education quality or an excellent institutional management system in the field of engineering, informatics or computer science, natural sciences and mathematics. In the accreditation process, the quality parameter is evaluated systemically in an integrated manner.

ASIIN views "education" as a developmental and learning process to acquire various competencies and outcomes. The result of education should support individual, social and professional development.

ASIIN has accredited 26 programs of Universitas Airlangga.

ABEST21

ABEST21, or The Alliance on Business Education and Scholarship for Tomorrow, a 21st-century organization, is based in Tokyo, Japan. It was founded in 2005 and recognized as an international business accreditation agency for business schools in the Asia-Pacific region. It has 60 business schools from 11 different countries as members.

The mission of ABEST21 is to advance education in business schools globally by encouraging mutual cooperation among its member institutions to face challenges in the 21st century. Some prominent Asian companies such as Toshiba, Sony, Toyota Motor, Panasonic, Fuji, Xerox, Nissan and Kodak have been partners of this accreditation agency.

This accreditation agency has a long history. In 1994, seven business schools from Japan and abroad joined together in a Global Classroom Conference, and the conference was reorganized as the Global Knowledge Network on June 28, 2002.

System development became an urgent issue for the Global Knowledge Network, significantly enhancing the quality of management education at business schools.

ABEST21 has accredited 15 programs of Universitas Airlangga.

ASIC

ASIC stands for Accreditation Service for International Schools, Colleges, and Universities. It is an international accreditation institution based in the United Kingdom (UK) and organized by the UK Home Office. ASIC has gained ISO 9001: 2015 accredited certification.

ASIC is one of the international accreditation institutions chosen by Universitas Airlangga to improve its educational quality. ASIC has been acknowledged and affiliated with the world's prominent education organizations, such as CHEA International Quality Group in the USA, British Quality

Foundation, ENQA, European Association for Quality Assurance in Higher Education, GUIDE Association, Global Universities in Distance Education, UN Academy Impact group, and The Association of International Education Administrators (AIEA).

Universitas Airlangga has gained ASIC accreditation for 14 programs.

This program is available for international students interested in some uniquely Indonesian perspective subjects in social and cultural aspects, economics, natural sciences, and health/life sciences.

LINGUA

(Learning Indonesian Language at Universitas Airlangga)

Adopting multiculturalism as a theme, the program took place around the Eastern Java region, exploring the region's vast diversity.
