The city of Jena: History meets modern technology

Jena is a modern and lively city in the heart of Germany. It's special charm stems from its historically important past, the beautiful surrounding countryside, and the innovative international research and industry, as well as the diverse cultural life.

A city of history and tradition

At the end of the 18th century, the city became Germany's most important intellectual centre – sparked by the presence of Johann Wolfgang von Goethe and Friedrich Schiller. In the nineteenth century, Jena developed into an industrial powerhouse thanks to the work of the three scientific and economic leaders Carl Zeiss, Otto Schott and Ernst Abbe.

Modern cultural scene

In addition to museums of technology, science, literature, and art history, there is also an attractive and diverse cultural scene in Jena. For example, the annual »Kulturarena«, an open-air festival that attracts international musicians. Also, there are plenty of topclass events among the wide range of performances at the Theatre, Art Society, and Philharmonic Orchestra.

Embedded in wonderful nature

The city is located in the Saale valley. It offers an almost Mediterranean landscape with limestone hills up to 400 metres high and has a variety of cycle paths and a charming area for taking a stroll or hike.

A Tradition of Innovation: The History of Friedrich Schiller University

Since its foundation in 1558, the Friedrich Schiller University of Jena has been consistently at the centre of intellectual movements in the humanities and natural sciences.

At the end of the 18th century, the University became a centre of classical German philosophy, hosting among others: Johann Gottlob Fichte, Friedrich-Wilhelm Joseph Schelling and Georg Wilhelm Friedrich Hegel. Also, Friedrich Schiller, who was a professor of history at the University, wrote several of his dramas in Jena.

In the nineteenth century, Jena was home to some of the worlds most renowned educational scientists such as Friedrich Fröbel and Peter Petersen. In the natural sciences, the most distinguished representative of evolution theory in Germany, Ernst Haeckel, did his groundbreaking research at the University of Jena.

The optician and mechanic Carl Zeiss, the physicist Ernst Abbe and the glass chemist Otto Schott formed an impressive collaboration at the end of the 19th century, a unique example of cooperation between science and industry, that has been shaping the profile of scientific research at Friedrich Schiller University Jena to this day.
