

Your home away from home

We're also here to help you find your on-campus residence or off-campus housing. If you're a first-year undergraduate student with a Provincial Attestation Letter (PAL) and apply by the fall housing application deadline, you'll be guaranteed a spot in first year or supported in finding an off-campus winter option.

If you're an English Language Institute student enrolled in a program that is eight months or longer, you'll also be guaranteed residence accommodation — conditional upon completing a residence application and paying the application fee by your residence offer deadline. If you apply for housing after the deadline, you'll be added to the waiting list.

If you prefer off-campus accommodation, are starting in January, or are in an ELI program that is less than eight months, the TMU Housing Office offers assistance in your housing search.

Apply to TMU

Are you ready to become a TMU student? Here is an overview of your next steps. Remember, you can find all this information and more at torontomu.ca/international/admissions/apply.

Step 1: Review your submission dates

Apply by the guaranteed consideration date of **October 15**, **2025**, to start at TMU in January 2026. Apply by the guaranteed consideration date of **February 1**, **2026**, to start at TMU in September 2026.

Step 2: Review your admission requirements

Ensure you meet the general university admission requirements, country-specific requirements based on where you completed your secondary schooling, special subject prerequisites and non-academic requirements (if applicable).

Step 3: Submit your application

Apply and submit your application through the TMU International Application Portal or through the Ontario Universities' Application Centre (OUAC).

Step 4: Upload your documents

Once you've received your application acknowledgment email, follow the steps to activate your online identity for your ChooseTMU Applicant Portal. Submit required documents and proof of English proficiency (if required).

Step 5: Check your application status

Log in to your ChooseTMU Applicant Portal to view letters and documents issued to you by Undergraduate Admissions and to track your application.
