



# THE PROGRAMME

The LLB programme (admission code: JS1061/1061) provides a sound preparation for the practice of law and for many other careers. Globalisation and rapid economic growth have created many new opportunities for law graduates in commerce, business and public life. The LLB programme offered by CityUHK is designed to help you develop into a competent, self-reliant and successful professional.

## Aims and Intended Learning Outcomes of Law Major

Law studies aim to:

- provide a liberal education in the theory and practice of law at the level and rigour appropriate for an undergraduate degree;
- equip students with a critical understanding of law and legal institutions so as to enable them to serve the needs of Hong Kong and the international community; and
- facilitate the development of a range of intellectual skills, in particular the ability to think analytically and critically, to solve problems, and to communicate effectively both orally and in writing.

## **Programme Structure**

In order to graduate, LLB students are required to complete 121 credit units comprising core law courses, law electives, and Gateway Education courses.

The core courses for LLB students comprise of Legal Methods, Research and Writing, Hong Kong Legal System, Law of Contract, Law of Tort, Constitutional Law, Administrative Law, Criminal Law, Land Law, Jurisprudence and Legal Theory, Company Law, Equity and Trusts, Public Law of the PRC, and Private Law of the PRC. Students contemplating entry to the legal profession must also study Law of Evidence and Commercial Law. Some of the LLB lectures will be given together with the Juris Doctor (JD). Joint teaching of LLB and JD courses enables students to work together and develop teamwork skills. Elective courses provide students with the opportunity to study specialised areas of law and develop a unique profile. Graduates who wish to practice law in Hong Kong will need to complete the Postgraduate Certificate in Laws (PCLL).

#### **JUPAS Applicants**

To be eligible for admission to the LLB programme (JS1061), the HKDSE applicant should achieve Level 5 or above in English Language and satisfy the University General Entrance Requirements.

- other equivalent qualifications.
