In the age of data, the world needs analytical thinkers who can:

- ▶ Extract scientific understanding from masses of societal data
- ▶ Use both quantitative and qualitative tools to make sense of global issues
- ▶ Explore multiple perspectives, discover patterns and hidden connections

You will gain these skills through a comprehensive training in computational data analysis and mathematical modelling, combined with a solid foundation in sociology, economics, environmental science and political science.

This includes learning how to use the unprecedented amount and quality of digital information available to understand and predict attitudes and opinions, social media and communication, political and economic behavior.

CEU offers you the opportunity to shape your academic journey through a wide range of electives and flexible combinations. Students in the Data Science and Society track begin with a core curriculum, then select a second focus area as a specialization or major.

Choose from **economics, politics and policy**, or **social and cognitive science**. In the three-year program, these are available as specializations; in the four-year program, they may count as majors, depending on credits.

This structure gives you both in-demand technical skills and the freedom to explore what inspires you most.


