HU VISION 2030

Hokkaido University has announced HU VISION 2030, its new medium-term roadmap for the future.

Science, technology, and innovation are now recognized as vital engines of growth in Japan's national strategy. Against this backdrop, universities are increasingly expected to create new value through collaboration with the public and private sectors. For Hokkaido University, this means bringing together *Excellence*—the pursuit of outstanding research and education—and *Extension*—the application of knowledge and expertise to address societal challenges.

In 2014, Hokkaido University launched the *Hokkaido University Future Strategy for the 150th Anniversary*, setting 2026 as its target year and outlining the direction the University would take toward that milestone. Building on this foundation, HU VISION 2030 looks ahead to 2030, four years beyond the previous target. It clarifies the roles of *Excellence* and *Extension* and sets out the University's medium-term approach to creating a dynamic ecosystem and virtuous cycle through their combined impact.
