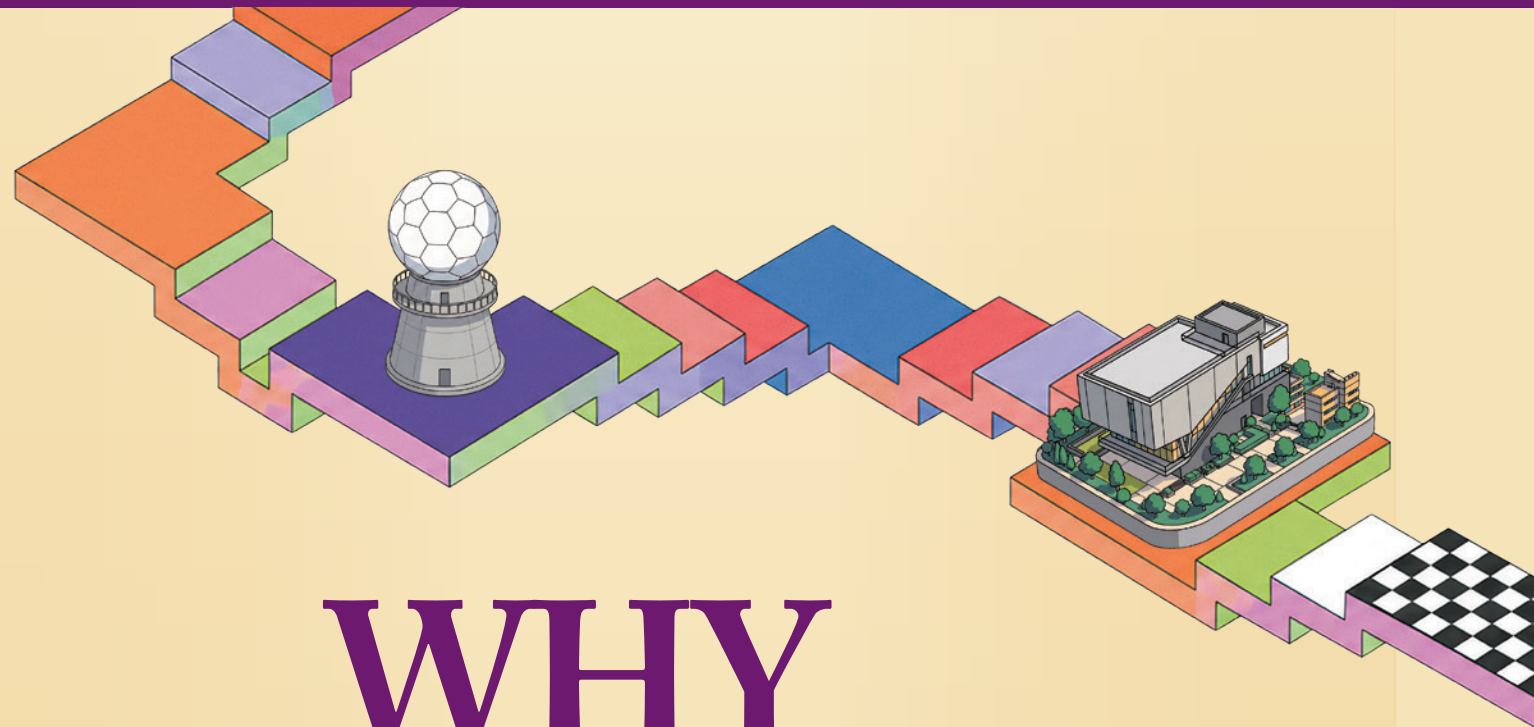

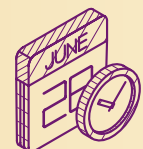

Founded in 1963, The Chinese University of Hong Kong (CUHK) has been recognised globally as a leading comprehensive research university and one of the finest in Asia. English is the major medium of instruction. Currently, we have over 5,500 non-local students from over 50 countries and regions.

Students can make the most of their university life with our unique college system and world-class facilities. There is an abundance of scholarship opportunities for students. Non-local students are guaranteed at least two years of on-campus accommodation*, with a hostel place provided in their first year.

**CUHK's N-2 residence policy allows international undergraduates to reside on campus for a period equivalent to their normative study period minus two years. However, some Colleges operate as fully residential Colleges, guaranteeing students on-campus accommodation throughout their period of study.*

Fully residential Colleges provide a vibrant living-learning environment in which students reside in College hostels and share communal meals. These regular interaction fosters meaningful exchanges and close connection between faculty members and undergraduates.

Colleges that are not fully residential are equipped with non-resident halls, which provide a supportive environment for all members. These facilities offer spaces for rest, recreation, and a wide range of student-led activities.

Teaching Excellence



As a top university in Hong Kong and Asia, CUHK aims to nurture students with both specialised knowledge and wisdom for life. The education experience here is distinguished by a flexible credit unit system, a college system, bilingualism, and multiculturalism. There are general education courses to broaden students' perspectives and develop their ability to face the challenges of contemporary society.

Our beautiful 138.4-hectare campus overlooking Tolo Harbour is the largest and greenest in Hong Kong. 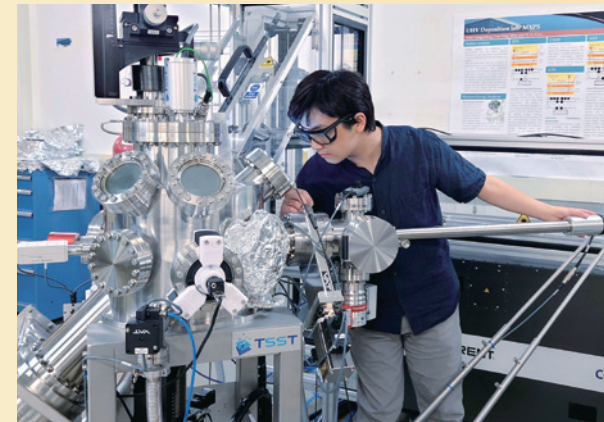

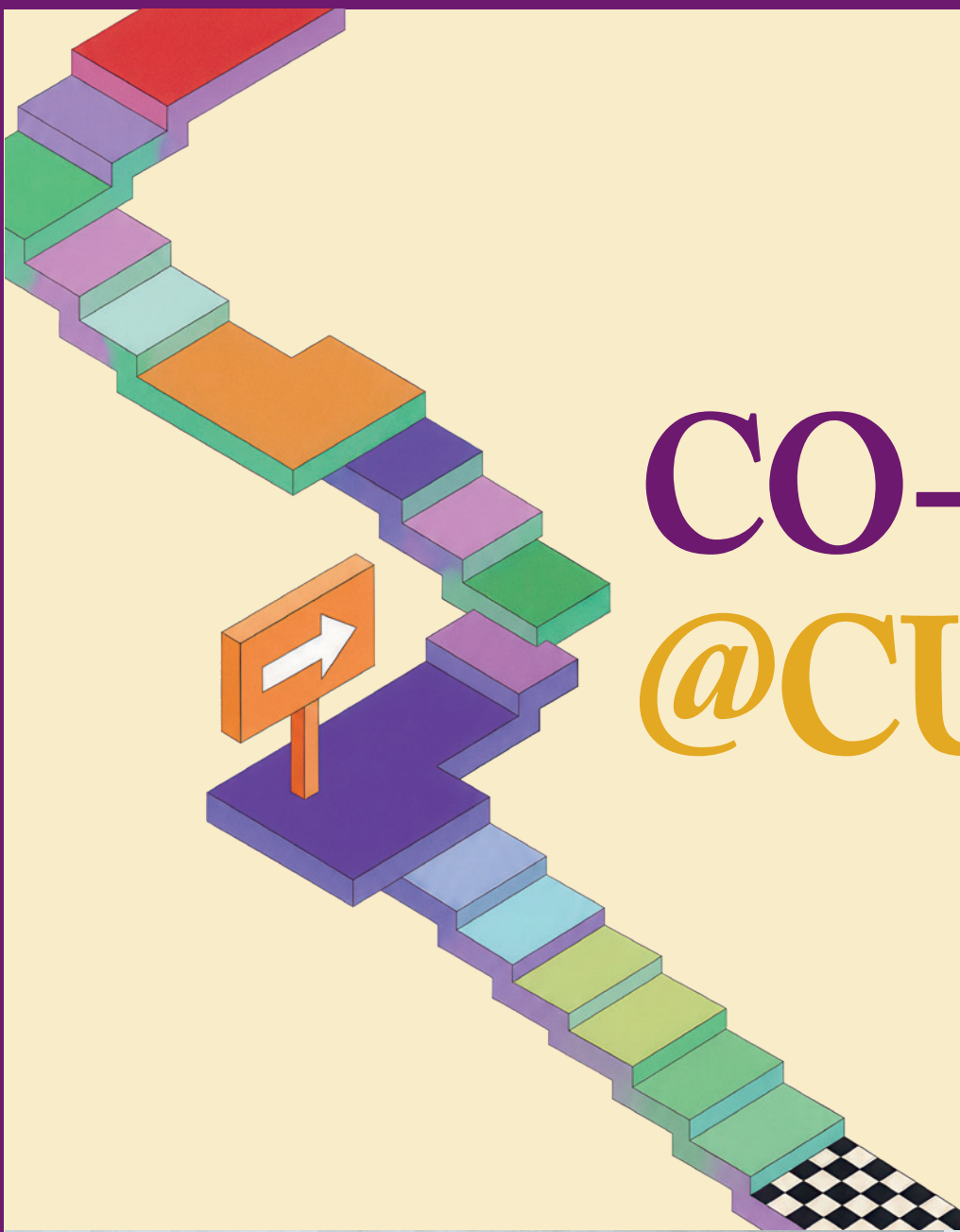
VIBRANT STUDENT LIFE ON-CAMPUS

CUHK's **Co-operative Education Programme** (Co-op@CUHK) is a university-wide, cross-disciplinary experiential learning initiative designed to create a triple win for students, employers, and the University. In today's fast-changing and competitive environment, Co-op@CUHK offers academically accredited opportunities for ambitious and driven students to jumpstart their career exploration. By integrating meaningful work experience with CUHK's tailored coursework, Co-op@CUHK empowers students to **develop soft skills, gain industry insights, and build professional networks** - all while earning their degree. Paid term-time placement no doubt enhances students' workplace acumen, thus increasing their employability upon graduation and shaping their career success in the long run.

Co-op@CUHK proudly stands as the first programme of its kind in Hong Kong. It is open to CUHK students in year two or above from all disciplines who demonstrate strong academic performance, diverse extracurricular engagement, and a positive, can-do attitude. The Programme collaborates with a broad spectrum of industry partners, including renowned multinational corporations operating in Hong Kong, emerging startups, non-profit organisations, and statutory bodies. Starting from Cohort 2023-24, Co-op students have the opportunity to undertake placements in the Chinese Mainland or Asian Region, including Japan, Singapore, Thailand, and Indonesia. The vast majority of corporate partners have expressed strong interest in considering Co-op students for future employment, reflecting both the calibre of CUHK's undergraduates and the quality of the University's education.

GLOBAL INTERNSHIP PROGRAMME (GIP)

Organised by the Office of Student Affairs, the **Global Internship Programme** provides students with summer and immersive work placements in key global hub cities—such as Beijing, Berlin, Brussels, Cape Town, Chengdu, Dubai, Jakarta, Kuala Lumpur, London, New York City, Shanghai, Singapore, Sydney, Tokyo, and Vancouver.

Through internships of a minimum of four weeks, students will not only enhance their language and interpersonal skills while gaining valuable workplace exposure. They would also broaden their horizons that are conducive to their personal growth and career development.
