

Thank you for your interest in studying at UKZN.

Please download an application form and information material from the UKZN website at www.ukzn.ac.za. On the website go to **Applications and Information** and select **Application Procedures,** then follow the information for **International Applicants**, undergraduate or postgraduate OR provide us with a postal address and we will mail application material to you. Note that:

- International undergraduate applicants must have their foreign school-leaving qualification evaluated by the Higher Education South Africa (HESA) Matriculation Board. Contact them at Tel. +27 (0)12 591 4401/2 or www.hesa-enrol.ac.za
- International postgraduate applicants must have their foreign qualifications evaluated by the South African Qualification Authority (SAQA). Contact them at: Tel +27 (0)12 431 5070 or www.saqa.org.za
- Undergraduate applicants must pay attention to the level of performance required in specific subjects at school. The point system does not apply to international applicants.
- Evaluated documents must be enclosed with your applications or submitted as soon as available. Selections cannot be made unless all required documentation is received. Official translations must be submitted if certificates are not in English.
- Note the level of performance required in English. Postgraduate studies require a higher command of English.
- Pay attention to the closing dates.
- An application fee must be paid on submission of forms: Countries in Africa and SADC pay R420 and other countries outside Africa pay \$130.

Medicine does not consider international applicants at undergraduate level other than in terms of Governmental agreements with SADC countries with no medical schools of their own. These applicants must apply via their Governments.
