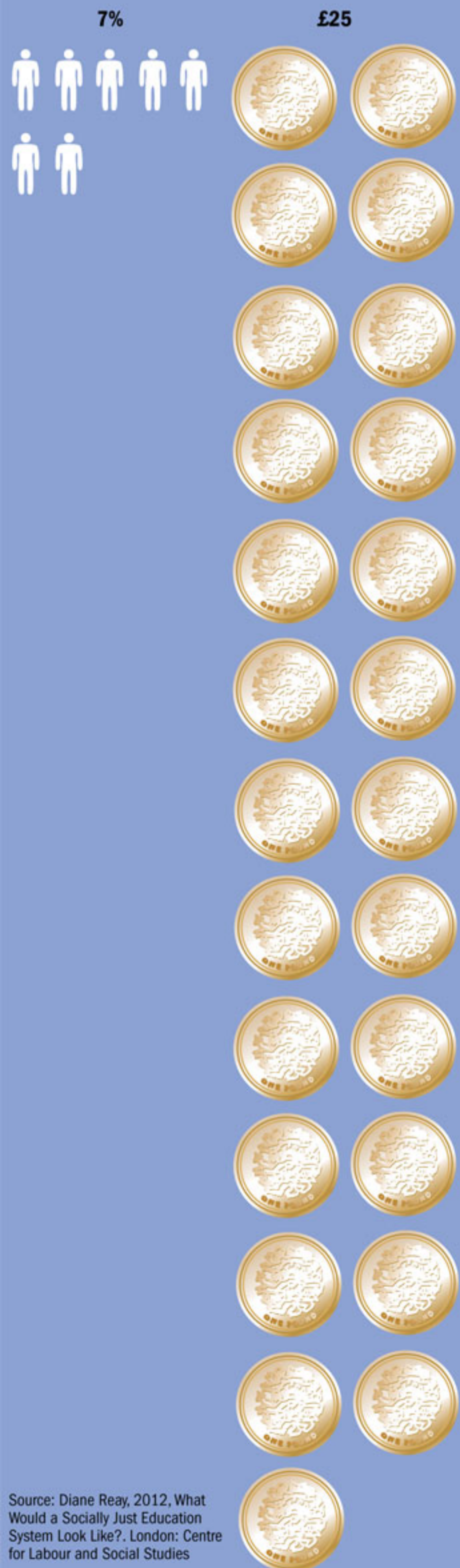


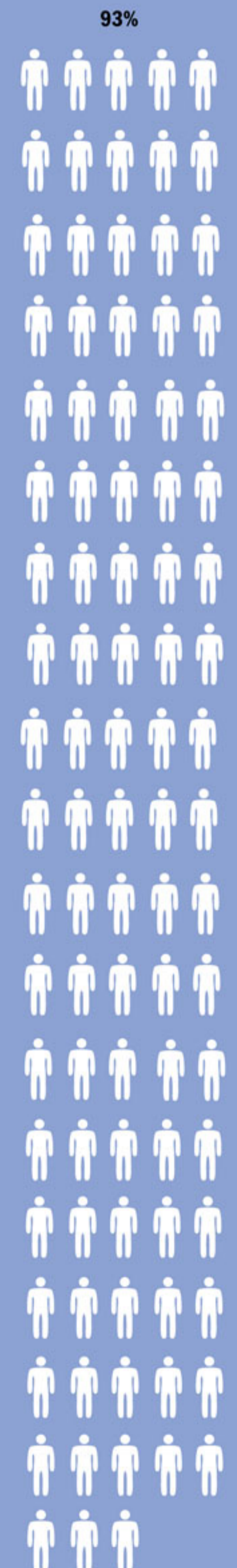
How every £100 spent on secondary education in the UK is distributed

The best-off 7 per cent of children in Britain have more than four times as much spent on their schools as the average child of the other 93 per cent

£3.57 is spent on each privately educated child



£0.80 is spent on each state-educated child
