PolyU is a vibrant and aspiring university committed to serving the needs of Hong Kong, the Chinese Mainland and the world through professional education and impactful research. On the education front, PolyU aims to unlock the potential of students, nurturing them to become leaders in their chosen field and socially responsible citizens who bring about positive change.
