The panel provide universities, governments and other organisations with the potential to gain detailed insight from this much sought after audience.








THE Student Pulse

Our panel currently comprises over 20,000 prospective students (predominantly international students), and is growing rapidly – at around 7,000 new panellists per month










The survey and respondent profile






Importance of being a sustainable citizen and awareness of the SDGs












Awareness of the UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)



This breaks down as:

- 29% aware with limited knowledge
- 28% aware with some knowledge
- 18% aware with good level of knowledge

Having some/good level of knowledge was higher among:

- Undergrad/postgrads (48%) vs. high school students (40%)
- International students (47%) vs. those studying or planning to study domestically (35%)







Highest priority SDGs – Top 3












Highest priority SDGs – by region










Impact 2021 submissions vs. students' priorities










Impact 2021 submissions (UK) vs. priorities of students seeking study in the UK


