Srinakharinwirot University

Srinakharinwirot University (SWU) was developed from two institutions: the Advanced Teacher Training School, founded in 1949 and the College of Education, founded in 1953. In 1974, it became a comprehensive university and was named Srinakharinwirot University. Currently, the university is an autonomous institute under the supervision of the Ministry of Higher Education, Science, Research and Innovation. The university has two main campuses: Prasarnmit campus located in central Bangkok and Ongkharak campus located in Nakhon Nayok province, about 70 kilometers north of Bangkok. SWU currently offers Bachelor's, Master's and Doctoral programs in 17 faculties and 4 colleges.
