- **2.** [Apostille/Consulate Authentication] High School Diploma or Certificate of (Expected) Graduation
- **3.** [Apostille/Consulate Authentication] Official Transcripts of all attended high schools or of the equivalence
- **4.** Personal Statement (English or Korean)
- **5.** Documents verifying the foreign nationality of the applicant, documents verifying the foreign nationality of his or her parents (e.g. copy of passports or identification cards), and legal documents evidencing the relationship between the applicant and his or her parents

Optional

- **1.** Recommendation Letter or Counselor Reference (English or Korean)
- 2. Documents verifying applicants' proficiency in the Korean language: Scores from the Korean Language Proficiency
 Test(TOPIK) or certificates from the Korean language institutes that are affiliated with any university in Korea
- 3. Additional Materials: Records of Personal Distinctions, Reports of Standardized Test Scores, such as ACT, AP, ATAR, GCE-A Level, IB, HKDSE, NCEA, SAT and etc. (Foreign language proficiency)

Qualifications

- High School Graduation Requirements
 Applicants must graduate from high school or that of the equivalence, recognized by regulation 98. under Elementary and Secondary Education Act before the 1st day of school.
- Nationality Requirements
 Applicants and both their parents should have non-Korean nationality.
- * If a student or either one of the student's parents has a dual citizenship with Korea, the student is not eligible for this track.

Evaluation

Yonsei University makes a comprehensive evaluation of each applicant by taking into consideration of his or her academic achievements and potential, as well as non-academic accomplishments. Transcripts, personal statement, scores of standardized tests (e.g., 高考, ACT, AP, ATAR (HSC), GCE-A Level, HKDSE, IB, NCEA, SAT, etc.), awards, certificates/licenses, and scores of language proficiency tests are all representative elements used for evaluating the applicants' qualifications. (Depending on the student, some may be asked to be interviewed separately.)
