3 Eligibility

****Applicants who hold dual Korean citizenship are prohibited from applying. Citizenship status is determined as that which is held at the date of the application deadline.**

1. Master's Programs and Integrated Master's & Doctoral Programs

A. International applicants must meet all of the following requirements:

- ① He or she holds (or is about to hold) a Bachelor's degree. ② He or she must be non-Korean nationals.
- ③ Both of his or her parents must be non-Korean nationals.
- B. Applicants of Korean origin (Entire Education Completed Abroad) must meet all of the following requirements:
 - ① He or she holds (or is about to hold) a Bachelor's degree. ② He or she must be non-Korean nationals.
 - ③ He or she received their entire elementary, junior high, high school, and undergraduate education outside of Korea at a comparable and equivalent level to that which is provided in Korea.

2. Doctoral Programs

A. International applicants must meet all of the following requirements:

- ① He or she holds (or is about to hold) a Master's degree ② He or she must be non-Korean nationals.
- 3 Both of his or her parents must be non-Korean nationals.
- B. Applicants of Korean origin (Entire Education Completed Abroad) must meet all of the following requirements:
 - ① He or she holds (or is about to hold) a Master's degree
 - ② He or she received their entire elementary, junior high, high school, and undergraduate education outside of Korea at a comparable and equivalent level to that which is provided in Korea
 - ③ He or she must be non-Korean nationals.

3. Eligibility for Language Proficiency

A. Applicants who want to apply for the following departments MUST meet required conditions:

(** Applicants to the following departments MUST submit the language proficiency test results by May 13th (Thu), 2021 with other application documents.)

**Those who take the 75th [April 11th (Sun)] TOPIK exam can apply with a test identification slip, but must submit a TOPIK certificate for the required level or higher by May 21st (Fri), 18:00, 2021. If the applicant cannot submit the required level of TOPIK, the applicant cannot pass the document screening.

- B. Except for the departments above, applicants must provide one of the following as proof of language proficiency:
 - ① Korean proficiency: a TOPIK certificate for level 3 or higher
 - **Those who take the 75th [April 11th (Sun)] TOPIK exam can apply with a test identification slip, and if the applicant gets TOPIK certificate level 3 or higher, the applicant should submit it by May 21st, 18:00, 2021.
 - ② English proficiency: a score report from a recognized English proficiency test such as: TOEFL 530 (CBT 197, iBT 71), IELTS (Academic) 5.5, CEFR B2, NEW TEPS 326 or higher
 - 3 Being a native speaker of English
 - * Applicants do not need to submit an English score report if they are from a country whose official language is English (USA, UK, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, Republic of South Africa, and Ireland).
 - 4 Applicants who have completed all years of undergraduate (for Master applicants) or master (for Doctoral applicants) fully in Korean or English, and can submit the official documents from the university proving that courses were taught fully in Korean/English.
 - (§) Applicants who do not have an authorized language proficiency test score, but have the ability to study in Korean or English.
 - * In case of ④ and ⑤ above, each department will evaluate applicant's language proficiency during the department interview, and the department should submit 'a confirmation letter of English or Korean proficiency' directly to the Office of International Affairs. (The applicant oneself does not submit it, but the department should submit it to KNU OIA.)

 - ② Application Number: Automatically created after you complete the on-line application.
- B. Submission of Applications: All required documents should be submitted to the Office of International Affairs by person or post.
 - ① Submission Period: April 26th (Mon) to May 13th (Thu), 2021 by 18:00
 - ② Where to Submit: The Office of International Affairs (Chemseongin Student Futures Support Building 2F)
 - ③ How to Submit: Applicants should submit completed and printed application forms downloaded from the online application site, along with required documents 1.~11. in section ⑤ Required Documents.

2. Qualification Screening

- A. Screening Period: May 14th (Fri) to 25th (Tue), 2021
- B. Screening Method: Examination of the suitability of applicants' academic background and language proficiency, so as to be deemed as "qualified" or "unqualified."

3. Department Screening (Interview)

- A. Screening Period: May 26th (Wed) to June 3rd (Thu), 2021
- B. Screening Method: Interview

- C. Each departments will make notice for the interview schedule and place.
- D. Comprehensive evaluation of the candidate's previous degree performance, language eligibility, study plan, and major knowledge, so as to be deemed as "qualified" or "unqualified" by each of applied majors.

2. Financial Documents

- B. Submission Period: After passing the department interview ~ June 25th (Fri), 2021
- C. Required documents to submit must meet one of the following:
 - ① Original bank certificate of deposit balance(in English) showing the amount of USD 18,000
 - * According to the Ministry of Justice's and Education Guidelines
 - * Submit bank deposit balance certificate in name of applicant's own name or a parent's name.
 - * Submit the certificate of employment or business registration certificate(English or Korean) of a parent's when submitting the balance certificate of the parent's name
 - * Bank deposit balance certificate under other names (friends, relatives except parents, etc) cannot be accepted.
 - * Issued within 30 days prior to the submission date

(KNU format will be provided to academic advisors directly upon request, and should be submitted directly from the professor to KNU OIA).

- C. Required documents: Successful applicants must submit one of the following documents:
- ① Apostille Certificate of your previous academic documents
- 2 Documents verified by the Korean Embassy in other countries or the Embassy in Korea
- ③ Documents confirmed by the China Academic Degree & Graduate Education Development Center (Only for applicants who hold a degree from universities in China) * Applicants who graduated from Universities in Korea can submit a copy of the degree instead of verified copies.

6 Application Fee : KRW 60,000

- 1. The application fee should be paid using the on-line payment system.
- 2. Failure to pay the application fee during the application period will result in cancellation.
- 3. You can get the application number after payment of the application fee.
- * NOTE: It is not possible to revise the contents of the application after payment.

7 Scholarships(KINGS: KNU International Graduate Scholarship) and Benefits

- 2. Benefits: 100% or 50% of tuition fees waived



8 Important Notes for Applicants

- 1. All documents should be in Korean or English. Documents in other languages should be accompanied by a notarized Korean or English translation.
- 2. If any required documents are found to be false or counterfeit, the applicant's admission will be canceled.
- 3. Applicants submitting a certificate of expected graduation must submit the original copy or a notarized copy of the graduation certificate before beginning their first semester (August 27th, 2021) at Kyungpook National University.
- 4. The Office of International Affairs is not responsible for the cancellation of admission due to incorrect contact information (such as address and phone number, etc.).
- 5. If an applicant's visa is not issued or is rejected, his or her admission will be cancelled.
- 6. Applicants receiving a scholarship of more than USD 18,000 from another institution are not required to submit a certificate of financial guarantee; however, they must submit a certificate/letter of confirmation from the institution that will pay their tuition during their period of study at Kyungpook National University.
- 7. Submitted documents or application fees will not be returned to the applicant. (Original copies of certificates of degree can be returned upon request after the screening process is completed.)
- 8. As many applications will be expected on the last day of the online application, please complete the application before the deadline.
- 9. Application number for each applicant will be created after your online application and it will be used frequently during the application process, so please note it.
- 10. If the applicant does not have sufficient academic ability, he/she may not be selected.
- 11. International students who are admitted to the university or enrolled at KNU must have Korean health insurance. According to the National Health Insurance Act and its Enforcement Decree, international students who stay in Korea more than 6 months must have National Health Insurance (국 민건강보험) in Korea from March 1st, 2021.
- 12. Further details, if not stated in this guide, will be in accordance with the Office of International Affairs at KNU.
