


Diversity in Modernity

It was named Ika Daigaku Shika until 1945, Tandheelkundig Instituut until 1947, Universiteir Tandheelkundig Instituut until 1948, and Dental Medicine Institute until 1953.

FKG UNAIR has collaborated with many international partners and universities, such as Malaysian universities (Malaysia Islamic Science University, University of Malaya, International Medical University, MAHSA University, Universiti Teknologi Malaysia); Japanese universities (Nagasaki University, Hiroshima University, Kagoshima University, Tohoku University, Osaka University, Niigata University, Kyushu University); South Korean universities (Chosun University, The Catholic University of Korea); Chinese universities (School of Stomatology, Peking University); Thai universities (Chulalongkorn University, Thammasat University, Khong Kaen University); American university (University of Arizona USA); European university (Queen Marry London); Australian university (Sydney University); and also universities from KSA (Taibah University Medina, King Abdul Aziz University).

Various facilities are available at FKH UNAIR including Veterinary Medicine Teaching Hospital, Educational Animal Park, Animal Development & Research Unit, Diagnostic Services, Poultry Disease Unit, Molecular Biology Lab, Animal Feed Lab, Invitro Lab, Frozen Cement Production Unit, BSL 3 (Biosafety Level 3). Other learning and research facilities are provided to support the teaching and learning process.

There are 32 international collaborations established by FKH UNAIR with international partners. The partner institutions are from Asia, Europe, Australia, America and Africa. Some of the countries are Malaysia, Thailand, Japan, Philippines, Taiwan, Myanmar, Vietnam; Germany, France; Australia, New Zealand; and several American and African countries. The collaboration is in the fields of education, research and publications, as well as community service. There are many programs offered by FKH UNAIR for international students such as inbound exchange program, AMERTA (Academic Mobility Exchange for Undergraduate at Airlangga), International Community Services, and other events on wild animal infection, wild aquatic, one health and zoonosis.



There are two community laboratories provided to support the fieldwork practice. The faculty also provides Audio Visual Aid (AVA) lab, Nutrition lab and computer labs. FKM UNAIR is one of the pioneers of public health education in Indonesia. To meet the demands of times and to get global recognition, international accreditation is a must. The units are Laboratory of Study and Development of Applied Psychology (LP3T), Center for Applied Educational Psychology (PTPP), Psychological Service Unit, Anak Ceria Early Education Center, and Center for Crisis and Community Development.

Universitas Airlangga has established international collaboration with School of Psychology, Faculty of Health, Queensland University of Technology (QUT) in conducting international class 2 + 2 Articulation Program or known as a double degree program. The 2 + 2 articulation program in Psychology is a joint implementation of double degree education where the first 2 (two) years of study is at Universitas Airlangga and the next 2 (two) years of study is at QUT that will result in a Bachelor of Psychology and Bachelor of Behavioral Science (Psychology). The program will be conducted in two universities, where the first two years of study is done at Faculty of Psychology Universitas Airlangga, Surabaya Indonesia, and the next two years will be implemented at the Kelvin Grove School of Psychology and Counseling Faculty of Health, QUT Australia.

Both educational programs have the same study component, but each has a different distinctive perspective of Psychology disciplines. The Faculty of Psychology Universitas Airlangga studied Psychology in general, especially in 4 areas of interest, Clinical and Mental Health, Development and Education, Industry and Organization, and Social and Personality. The School of Psychology and Counseling Faculty of Health QUT, on the other hand, focuses on the study of Counseling Psychology, especially the application in the field of health.

4 Programs PSDKU or Off Main Campus Study Program is a part of Universitas Airlangga that provides bachelor's degree education in Banyuwangi. There are four bachelor's degree programs, Accounting, Veterinary Medicine, Public Health, Aquaculture. The organization of education off main campus was based on the decree of Minister of Education, and Cultural Affairs dated 24 July 2014 number 274/E/O/2014 about the permit for organizing programs of Universitas Airlangga in Banyuwangi.

The establishment of the program was also based on the request of Banyuwangi Regency government in the letter of General Directorate of Higher Education No. 276/E.E2/DT/2014 about the mandate of PSDKU UNAIR programs establishment in Banyuwangi. The national Education Minister Regulation (Permendiknas) Number 20 in 2011 on the establishment of higher education programs off main campus became the legality for PSDKU Banyuwangi's establishment.

There are two campuses of PSDKU UNAIR in Banyuwangi. The first one is at Jalan Wijaya Kusuma 113, Giri Subdistrict, Banyuwangi, and the second one is at Jalan Ikan Wijinongko 18-A, Sobo, Banyuwangi Sub-district, Banyuwangi. Giri Campus is for Aquaculture and Veterinary Medicine programs, while Sobo Campus is for Public Health and Accounting programs.

We can use any means of transportation to reach PSDKU UNAIR in Banyuwangi. We can go to Banyuwangi by air through Blimbingsari Airport, Banyuwangi and by land we can use the bus or train. However, the train is preferable transportation to reach Giri Campus as the train railway station is nearby to the campus location. The campus location is close to Banyuwangi railway station. It is only four minutes away to get to the campus from the railway station. It takes 15 minutes to get to Sobo Campus from Giri Campus.

Even though PSDKU UNAIR in Banyuwangi is newly established, it has provided quality education in the south-east of East Java. It has given major supports for its region's potentials in animal husbandry and marine science through its programs. PSDKU UNAIR also educates public health and accounting practitioners in Banyuwangi through its curriculum.

Several student activities are focused on student development and economic potential of Banyuwangi community. Academics are involved in each program seminar and community service. These contributions are to improve the quality of human resources in Bayuwangi district, according to the original purpose of PSDKU UNAIR Banyuwangi campus.

The academic community of PSDKU Banyuwangi also pay great attention to research. It can be seen from numerous scientific paper submissions qualifying in Student Creativity Program. ASEAN University Network (AUN) is a network of leading higher education institutions in South East Asia to accelerate and develop the quality of higher education in the region. It was a result of 4th ASEAN Summit and established in November 1995. It is expected to hasten the solidarity and development of regional identity through the promotion of human resource development.



AUN currently has 30 member universities. From Indonesia, there are four state universities as members, Universitas Airlangga, Universitas Indonesia (UI), Universitas Gadjah Mada (UGM) and Bandung Institute of Technology (ITB).

AUN is tasked as a key implementing agency of ASEAN in the Socio-cultural portfolio. AUN conducts programmes and activities to encourage and promote higher education cooperation and development to enhance regional integration in achieving global standards.

AUN recognizes the importance of quality in higher education, and the need to develop the holistic quality assurance system to raise academic standards and enhance education, research, and services among its member universities. AUN-QA conducts a systematic, structured and continuous assessment in the member universities. It is a self-assessment by writing SAR (Self-Assessment Report). The papers' completeness then confirmed and Action for Improvement is formulated from the result of SAR. After that, reviewer team visit the university, to assess and review the self-assessment report.

For UNAIR, international certification through AUN-QA is an essential effort to develop its quality of education. Most of Universitas Airlangga's degree programs are encouraged to get international certifications such as AUN-QA. There will be continuous efforts made to increase the number of programs with international certification, not only in ASEAN region but also in greater scale. All those efforts are made to achieve quality of education that meets the global standards.

ABEST 21

ABEST21 or The Alliance on Business Education and Scholarship for Tomorrow, a 21st-century organization, is based in Tokyo, Japan. It was founded in 2005 and recognized as an international business accreditation agency for business schools in the Asia-Pacific region. Its current members are 59 business schools from 18 different countries.

The mission of ABEST21 is to advance education in business schools on a global basis by encouraging mutual cooperation among its member institutions to face the challenges in 21st century. Some prominent Asian companies such as Toshiba, Sony, Toyota Motor, Panasonic, Fuji, Xerox, Nissan and Kodak are some of the partners of this accreditation agency.

This accreditation agency has a long history. In 1994, seven business schools from Japan and abroad joined together in a Global Classroom Conference, and the conference was reorganized as the Global Knowledge Network on June 28, 2002.

Global Knowledge Network considered it an urgent issue to develop a system to enhance the quality of management education at the business schools. With this idea in mind, on June 28, 2004, at the Hakone Conference, the establishment of network aiming at the enhancement of management education at member schools was discussed, and the preparation to establish THE ALLIANCE ON BUSINESS EDUCATION AND SCHOLARSHIP FOR TOMORROW, a 21st-century organization (ABEST21) was started. A year later, on July 1, 2005, assisted by 16 business schools from the world, the Network decided to establish ABEST21 as a mutual evaluation institution.

Universitas Airlangga also collaborates with ABEST21 to support its business education quality. It is important to get global recognition to achieve Top 500 World Universities in 2020. UNAIR program which has achieved ABEST21 international accreditation is Master's Program of Management.

This achievement shows UNAIR's strong commitment to internationalization. It is the key and access to improve quality of Indonesian human resources through higher education. The master's program got its membership, and it has been active in ABEST21 activities. Some other programs in Faculty of Economics and Business are encouraged to submit accreditation requests in order to achieve international standards.

Airlangga Global Engagement Programs

Through Airlangga Global Engagement (AGE), Universitas Airlangga continues to make innovations to attract interests of international students to join programs at UNAIR. Here are some of the programs offered by AGE:

AMERTA (Academic Mobility Exchange for Undergraduate at Airlangga)

This program is designed to allow international undergraduate students to experience diverse culture of Indonesia for one or two semesters. It has been a regular program for five years. AMERTA opens registration in Spring (February-June) and Fall (August-December). More than 60 international students are participating this year. The students are from ASEAN, European and American countries. The participants of Amerta program get a living allowance for IDR 3 million for each quarter of the year. They are given freedom to choose four courses in one semester. They do not only learn in campus, but also from trips to various places to explore and learn the culture of Indonesia.

CERIA (Community Empowerment Program at Airlangga)

This program is a community service program for international students. It is designed for students who are interested in gaining new knowledge into disadvantaged society in Indonesia. The program is organized for three weeks in June and July, but it is possible to be extended for the partner university's need and request.



Airlangga Development Scholarship (ADS)

ADS is a scholarship provided by UNAIR for international postgraduate students. Various courses of Economics, Islamic Economics, Public Health, Medicine, Social and Political Science, Media, Literary and Cultural Studies are available. The courses are delivered in Indonesian, so the students learn Indonesian intensively for a year. It is also a program which introduces and promotes Indonesian language to international students.

Airlangga Global Day

This program is an international education fair. This year, it is organized for the third time. There are some activities in this event. A lot of information on college studies, scholarships for local and international students are provided. There is also a workshop on preparation to study abroad.

Airlangga Summer Program: AIRVENTURE (Airlangga Adventure)

This two week program is for undergraduate and master students. It is designed for students interested in learning more about natural and cultural resources of Indonesia. Through on-site visit, field trips and workshop, the students are expected to get handson experience and empower the community through community service, such as learning together with the community on nature's conservation. The students also learn Indonesian with the locals.



Indonesian Heritage (JOINT SUMMER PROGRAM UNAIR-UNS)

This program is aimed to give chances to international students to study some of Indonesian treasured assets and understanding about general knowledge of Indonesian cultures, such as making Batik and traditional herbal drink. The program is held for ten days for undergraduate and master students. UNAIR collaborates with Universitas Sebelas Maret to organize this program.

Summer in SURA-BALI (JOINT SUMMER PROGRAM UNAIR-UKP-UNUD)

This is a community empowerment program through sociopreneurship. The participants are introduced to sociopreneurship and culture of Indonesia, both theoretically and practically in two big regions, Surabaya and Bali. In the end of the program, students are expected to have the competence in identifying sociopreneurship activities, mapping the challenges and offering ideas to improve social enterprises in the global setting. This program is organized in collaboration with Universitas Kristen Petra and Universitas Udayana. (*)

Established on June 14, 2011, Universitas Airlangga Hospital (RS UNAIR) was appointed by the government to be a pilot project of teaching hospital in Indonesia. UNAIR Hospital which provides service to Healthcare and Social Security Agency (BPJS Kesehatan) patients, also has excellent resources, services and facilities.

UNAIR Hospital does not only provide medical services. It also organizes activities for the senior citizens, research visit, free cataract surgery and other activities. In 2015, UNAIR Hospital was awarded The Most Trusted Hospital and Quality Service of The Year.

As a teaching hospital, it has supporting facilities for educational activities such as lecture rooms, study, Medical Specialist Professional Education (PPDS) Room, discussion and coordinating room, resident room and research ethics room.

Excellent services are given through its Geriatric Clinic, Airlangga Aesthetic Center, Neurosurgery Center Surabaya, Varicose Clinic, Integrated Complementary Traditional Healthcare Service Unit, Microtia Center, Integrated Oncology Clinic, and Integrated Digital Design Research Center for Medical, which is a collaboration unit with Sepuluh Nopember Institute of Technology (ITS).

There are also conventional services such as hemodialysis unit, inpatient services, ICU/ICCU/NICU/PICU, 26 specialist and sub-specialist clinics, Medical Check-Up service, radiology unit and laboratories, Home Care Unit, and 24/7 Ambulance and Emergency Installation.

The hospital which has gained the highest level of accreditation by Hospital Accreditation Commission (KARS) and international accreditation in 2019 is currently supported by 121 medical specialists, 32 general practitioners and dentist, 336 nurses and midwives, and other staffs reaching 827 in total.

Airlangga University Dental Hospital or Rumah Sakit Gigi dan Mulut Universitas Airlangga (RSGM Universitas Airlangga) provides general, specialist, emergency services including emergency dental care. RSGM is a teaching hospital. It means the treatment is given by a variety of dental professionals, including students, specialists in training or other qualified staff. The Dental Hospital is equipped with 6 beds, High Care Unit with 2 beds and two modern Operating Rooms.

It offers a wide range of services such as dental cleaning, gum diseases, tooth filling, orthodontic treatment, crowning, tooth replacement with denture in partial or full denture, dental implant, tooth extractions, wisdom tooth removal, root canal, and other treatments. It also provides oral and maxillofacial surgery for patients who needs surgical intervention as in oral and maxillofacial trauma, infections, cleft lip and palate and correction of maxillofacial skeletal deformities by orthognathic surgery. Its experts have the most advanced technologies in handling the patients and keeping their oral health at its best.

Veterinary Medicine Teaching Hospital was built to develop an ideal veterinary hospital with modern facilities, professional and competent hospital staffs that uphold ethical values while continuously provides and improves excellent service to the community.

The four-story building is located in Campus C of Universitas Airlangga, right next to Faculty of Veterinary Medicine on Jalan Dharmahusada Permai, Mulyorejo. The building was officially inaugurated in April 2018. However, the hospital has been operating since 2004.

The veterinary medicine teaching hospital is expected to expand the scope of veterinary service provided for livestock commodity and pets. The hospital is also referred by vets, regional laboratory and veterinary health centers (Puskeswan) in East Java.

This hospital opens on weekdays (Monday-Friday) from 8 AM to 5 AM. On Saturday, it opens at 9 AM and closes at 1 PM. The clinics provide services to 75 patients in a day, and they are always encouraged to improve the service.

Veterinary Medicine Teaching Hospital of Universitas Airlangga is expected to perform three functions, providing veterinary service, conducting education and giving recreational service. The first one is about providing medical treatments to animals. For its educational function, academic community of Universitas Airlangga, either resident students or instructors, are always involved in the service. For the last function, there is a vaccination and grooming service for pets. It is aimed to provide comforts to animals.

The synergy of Faculty of Veterinary Medicine and this hospital is aimed to optimize their roles, especially about the learning or education. The hospital is expected to improve the competences of Faculty of Veterinary Medicine graduates.







Ksatria Airlangga Floating Hospital

Ksatria Airlangga Floating Hospital was initiated by alumni of Faculty of Medicine Universitas Airlangga (FK UNAIR) in the Symposium on Adventure and Remote Medicine during the commemoration of 62nd Anniversary of UNAIR in November 2016. The hospital is an alternative solution in health problems in remote areas to achieve "Health for all."

The floating hospital has the vision to realize healthy, happy, and content people in remote islands with a clean, healthy, and sustainable environment as a manifestation of social justice for all Indonesian people. There is a spirit to ensure all the people in the archipelago have access to complete healthcare services.

Ksatria Airlangga Floating Hospital provides basic health services, including general examination and treatment, dental and oral health services. It also provides proactive referral health services, including surgical, eye disease, obstetrics and gynaecological, internal medicine and paediatric health services.

Ksatria Airlangga Floating Hospital also conducts primary research and resuscitation by building basic data on the health of the maritime community through identification of urgent problems, resuscitation of 100 days, material provision for definitive planning of development in the health sector (with reference to basic data).

The hospital is equipped with 2 operating rooms: general and eye surgery, recovery room, sterilization room, administration room, changing room, medicine storage room, laboratory, medical team space, cabin crew room and kitchen.

In a certain period of time, before heading to certain remote islands, the floating hospital always recruits volunteers, from doctors, medical specialists, dentists, anaesthetic staff, surgeons, nurses, pharmacists, public health practitioners to documentation personnel.

Since October 2017, it has provided treatments to 15,000 patients, including 1,778 surgeries. From one mission to Bawean Island, Kangean Island, Sapeken Island, and Kalimas port, 3,512 patients were handled, with 574 surgeries performed, including 32 surgeries after an earthquake hit North Lombok.

UNAIR Libraries

Universitas Airlangga has three libraries located in three campuses, Campus A, Campus B and Campus C. The main library and the biggest one is the one in Campus B. There are 60 staffs working and supporting the students in the libraries. They consist of 25 librarians and 35 administrative staffs.

Libraries of Universitas Airlangga offer some services such as e-library, special collection services, magazine service, reference service, training service, reading room, discussion room, American Corner and Aussie Corner.

Printed Information Service

It is a collection of UNAIR Library accessible online through OPAC (Online Public Access Catalogue) on http://ailis.lib.unair.ac.id/opac/. The collections include Special Collection I, Special Collection II, general collection, reference collection, magazine and printed journals.

The number of books in the libraries, as recorded by the new system of Airlangga Integrated Library System (AILIS) reached 139,469 titles with 197,738 total copies. They are divided into Campus A, B and C. In addition to the three libraries, each faculty in UNAIR also has its own library.

e-Library

It provides information and references in digital forms such as e-journals and e-books. UNAIR subscribes e-resources consist of 57 databases, 35,964 titles of e-journals, 14,498 e-books and 1.5 million collections of dissertations subscribed from providers.



School of Advanced Technology and Multidisciplinary

In 2020, Universitas Airlangga is opening five new programs:

Industrial Engineering

This program provides insights and knowledge needed in an industrial process, which covers various fields. It includes industrial system and process optimization, especially the efficiency and productivity aspects. Students will also study the role of the organization and human's role in an industry, so the students will also have managerial skills.

Electrical Engineering

This engineering discipline concerned with the study of electricity, electronics and electromagnetism and their application in daily life. It includes the concept, design, development and production process of electrical and electronic devices.

Nanotechnology Engineering

The program is the practice of engineering on the nanoscale. Nano-sized materials are manipulated to create a new object with desired characteristics. One of the examples of nanotechnology product is the clothes made of specially-engineered fibers that make the people wearing them stay warm in winter.

Robotics and Artificial Intelligence Engineering

This engineering discipline focuses on robots and artificial intelligence development. Students will be taught how to build a robot or artificial intelligence such as Sophia, Siri. Alexa and Cortana.

Data Science Technology

Data is currently considered as the most valuable currency. Learning Data Science Technology will be beneficial for the future. It is a multi-disciplinary field that uses scientific methods, algorithms and systems to acquire an in-depth understanding of some data, either in a well-structured form or otherwise.
