COURSES

A variety of courses are offered in English by individual colleges and departments, along with courses specially designed to offer a new perspective and understanding of Korea. The list of courses taught in English will be available in the middle of January for the following spring semester or July for the following fall semester. In addition, this list will be sent to all accepted exchange students by email with instructions on course registration. Exchange students can take up to 18 - 21 academic credits per semester (depending on major), and most courses are worth three credits.
