

I. UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMS

Graduated from high school, equivalent to high school diploma in Vietnam or International Baccalaureate (IB) from score 26.

II. MASTER'S PROGRAMS

Graduated from University in the right major or in other close majors. Bachelor's degree delivered by foreign educational institutions must comply with the current regulations.

III. DOCTORAL PROGRAMS

Bachelor degree with excellent grade or Master degree in the right major or other equivalent majors.

Language Proficiency Requirements

For Vietnamese Training programs: B2 in Vietnamese (level 4/6) of Vietnamese language ability framework for foreigners For English Training programs: TOEFL iBT 79+ or IELTS 5.5+. Students are native speakers are exempted.
