

CUHK has also pioneered the Global Internship Programme providing students with internship opportunities in Mainland China and across the world, such as Beijing, Berlin, Jakarta, Kuala Lumpur, London, New York City, Shanghai, Sydney, Tokyo, Vancouver, and more.

During the pandemic, non-local students had the option to participate in the virtual internship programme and complete offshore placements in their home country. More than 7,600 students have returned from internship throughout the two decades.
