

YOUR COMMUNITY – ACCOMMODATION

While you settle into University life on campus, we understand that every student has different needs and considerations. Whether you choose to live in student accommodation or commute from your home, our student support teams are with you every step of the way. We will ensure that you get the best out of your time with the University of Birmingham Dubai.

You could be a postgraduate student already living in the city of Dubai or an undergraduate student moving away for the first time. Wherever you choose to live, you will be an integral part of our Birmingham community. As well as the induction activities that you will take part in during Welcome Week, you will have the opportunity to mix with your peers in social settings, which include excursions, trips and social activities.

Accommodation

Your University experience is about much more than studying and learning. Outside the lecture room you need somewhere to relax and make the most of your free time.

There is a wide variety of safe and modern accommodation options for students near to the University of Birmingham Dubai. Dedicated student accommodation providers typically offer en-suite accommodation in shared apartments, where rooms are either single or double occupancy.

These types of accommodation also tend to offer facilities such as gyms and social spaces, with basic costs of Wi-Fi and utilities usually included in the fee.

We are able to provide you with details of recommended accommodation providers to meet your requirements. Alternatively, we can assist you in finding a private apartment in Dubai. Shuttle transport services will be provided at key times between our campus and our recommended accommodation providers.

Cost of accommodation

The cost of accommodation will vary depending on your lifestyle choice. Most accommodation providers will require you to pay a deposit of rent in advance, meaning that as well as having a monthly budget for accommodation costs, you will need access to additional funds initially to secure your tenancy.



SCHOLARSHIPS

Birmingham attracts the best and brightest students from across the globe. To ensure we recognise students who will flourish at the University of Birmingham, a number of scholarships are available for students applying for 2019 entry. Contact us to find out more.

Chancellor's Award Scholarship

Birmingham has a distinguished history of attracting the brightest minds, with our former students going on to win Nobel Prizes and achieving success in business and government worldwide. As a commitment to these outstanding students joining us in Dubai, we are offering a select number of scholarships, worth up to 104,000 AED and equivalent to up to 30% of the annual tuition fee for each year of your programme (subject to academic achievement). These awards are available to students on all programmes, at both undergraduate and postgraduate level.



Chancellor's Full Scholarship

For students who combine academic excellence with demonstrable evidence of extracurricular talent or impact (eg, volunteering, charity or community work, sports, music or the arts), we are delighted to be able to offer a number of fully funded scholarships. Awards will cover the total cost of tuition fees (which could amount to over 300,000 AED) and applications are invited from those students that are predicted or have achieved top grades in their high school exams.

Pioneers Award

As we embark upon our flagship Dubai campus, we are keen to invest in those students who commit to studying with the University of Birmingham Dubai. If you apply and receive an offer which you accept early you will receive your first year's tuition fee.



In order to be eligible for any of our scholarships, first you will need to receive an offer from us. You will then be invited via email to apply for our awards.

FUNDING AND PAYMENT OPTIONS

How much does it cost to attend university?

Find out more about international fees and living costs.



When you are planning your finances for studying in Dubai, you will need to consider two main costs:

- Tuition fees, which are your contribution to the cost of learning
- Living costs, which will include travel, accommodation, food and day-to-day expenses

Tuition fees

Studying at a UK university in Dubai means you will need to pay an annual fee for your tuition, which covers the costs associated with teaching, examinations and graduation. Your annual tuition fee depends on the level at which you study.

If you are made an offer to study by the University your tuition fees will be confirmed in your offer letter.

Securing your place

As a condition of study, you must pay a tuition fee deposit at the time of accepting your offer. Exceptions may apply, for example, if your fees are paid by a recognised sponsor.

Payment options

Your deposit is an advance payment of tuition fees and secures your place subject to meeting your offer criteria. It will be deducted from the fees charged to you after you register for your programme.


You can either pay the outstanding tuition fee for the academic year at the start of your programme or benefit from a termly instalment payment plan.

Living costs

The cost of living in Dubai will depend upon your lifestyle choice but it is possible to live economically if you shop wisely and budget carefully. Basic products and services are reasonably priced and there are regular sales and promotions on consumer goods.

You will need to consider costs such as visas, accommodation and transport.



Student visas

If you're a non-UAE national, you will need to obtain a visa to be able to study in Dubai (with the exception of GCC nationals).

To ensure that this is as smooth as possible for you, we provide support to ensure you can navigate your way through the application process. This includes:

- The type of visa you need and how to renew for each year of your studies
- How to obtain your visa and when to make your application
- Costs involved
- Requirements for medical insurance

PGCE in Primary Education (Teaching Studies) – 1 year, full time

What will you study?

Suitable for those interested in becoming a teacher across the full 5–11 age range, the Primary Education programme is a full-time one-year postgraduate programme taught at both our campus and with placements in our partnership schools. PGCE in Secondary English Education (Teaching Studies) – 1 year, full time


What will you study?

This programme will enable students to become reflective, confident practitioners, as well as offering a strong conceptual framework about education, children, English and classroom teaching.

PGCE in Secondary Mathematics Education (Teaching Studies) – 1 year, full time

What will you study?

Designed for those who want to teach pupils aged 11–18, the Secondary Mathematics Education programme is a full-time, one-year postgraduate programme and includes study around teaching methods, school-based work and whole-school issues. The programme develops a deep understanding of issues and complexities that surround the teaching and learning of mathematics. We wish to develop you as a thinking teacher who can be aware of choices in how to teach mathematics and make informed decisions about how you work with students. PGCert in Inclusion and Special Educational Needs – 1 year, part time

What will you study?

The Inclusion and Special Educational Needs (ISEN) programme is a 60-credit postgraduate certificate designed for in-service teachers, school leaders, education policy leaders, and others working directly or indirectly with children with disabilities in the UAE, the UK, and around the world.

The ISEN programme covers a range of topics, specifically: cross-cultural disability theory, inclusive policy and evaluation, and inclusive classroom practices. Students in the ISEN PGCert programme will take three 20-credit modules over the course of one year:

- Cross-Cultural Issues in Special Educational Needs and Disabilities
- Inclusion: Individual and Group Differences
- Evaluation and Policy Analysis for Inclusive Education

The ISEN programme is taught through a blended approach of digital and face-to-face learning. Students will engage in one module per term and modules are designed on activity and project-based

learning strategies that engage students to reflect on, and innovate, their professional practices to promote the inclusion of all students.

2 Your application will be considered. This will take up to five to ten working days after your application and supporting documents have been received. An application cannot be considered until all the necessary supporting documents have been received, such as references and transcripts, as we want to have all the available information about you.

4 If you accept and meet all of the conditions of your offer and pay your tuition fee deposit, we will confirm your place.

Supporting documents

For all programmes, you will need to provide supporting documents with your application.

These include:

- Transcript or statement of results of your highest qualification or predicted grades (originals or certified copies are not required at the application stage)
- One or two references
- If English is not your native language, a copy of your IELTS, TOEFL or Pearson Academic English Test certificate
- A copy of your passport personal details page

Your offer

Your offer letter will detail the requirements still to be met before your place will be confirmed. Offer holders are advised to fulfil their conditions as soon as possible to allow sufficient time to obtain a visa if required, along with Dubai Health Authority approved medical insurance.
