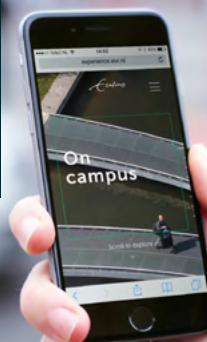

The table below provides an indication for two common entry diplomas: International Baccalaureate (IB) and A-levels. IB	Minimum point requirements range from 30 to 33
IB Math	Ranges from no math requirement to, for example, Analysis & Approaches HL requirement
A-Levels	Ranging from passing grades to specific results such as A A B (B) with Advanced Maths
