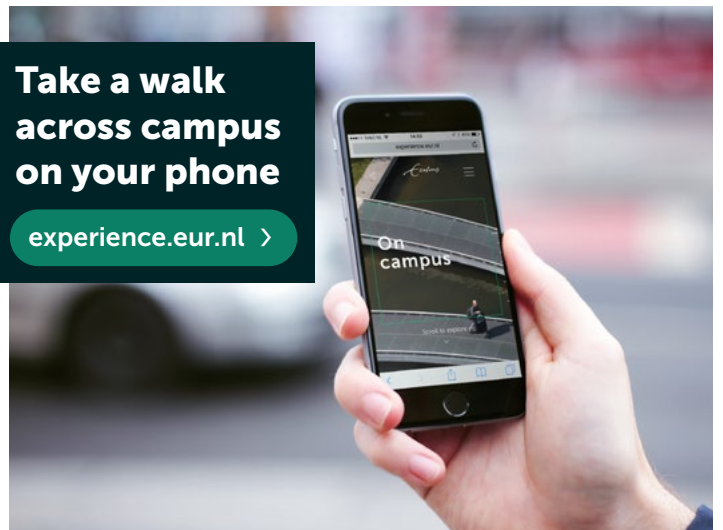

A range of requirements

We welcome students from many different countries and backgrounds. Requirements vary by programme – grades, type of diploma, and motivation will be considered for acceptance. The table below provides an indication for two common entry diplomas: International Baccalaureate (IB) and A-levels. For specific requirements, visit [the study programme page](#).

IB	Minimum point requirements range from 30 to 33. Math ranges from no requirement to, for example, Analysis & Approaches HL.
A-Levels	Ranging from passing grades to specific results such as A A B (B) with Advanced Maths.
