A range of requirements

We welcome students from many different countries and backgrounds. Requirements vary by programme – your grades, type of diploma, and motivation will be considered for acceptance. IB	Minimum point requirements range from 30 to 33
IB Math	Minimum requirements range from Math Studies to Math Higher Level (5)
A-Levels	Ranging from passing grades to specific results such as A A B (B) with Advanced Maths
