Reasonable tuition & one-year programmes

Dutch higher education offers incredible value; programmes for the 2020–2021 academic year will cost just over €2,000 for European Union (EU)/ European Economic Area (EEA) students. For students from other parts of the world tuition depends on your programme, and ranges from €4,100 to €26,300.

The majority of our master programmes take one year. However, there are some part-time opportunities or variations – such as research masters for those who wish to continue to a PhD and executive programmes for professionals – that take up to two years.
