Course offering: Language courses	A two-week intensive Spanish course is offered before the beginning of each semester. An additional fee applies as this course is not part of the regular academic offering. Multiple levels of Spanish for foreign students are also offered during each semester. Courses in other world languages are also offered; see academic offering for details.
Full time studies per semester	Exchange students must take a minimum of 10 USM credits per semester.

Semester Dates	First semester 2017: March-July (exact dates to be defined) Second semester 2017: August-December (exact dates to be defined)
Application deadline(s) for admission	Applications for the first semester of each year are from September 1-October 30. They are open for the second semester of each year from March 1-April 30.
Language requirements (TOEFL score, IELTS, etc) for undergraduate and graduate students.	Students should have a minimum of 3 semesters of college-level Spanish before beginning regular classes at the USM. A Language Requirement Form is requested to non-native Spanish speaker, which must be signed by the student and the coordinator. Alternatively you have the option to document your Spanish skills by attaching a proficiency certificate in Spanish indicating a minimum of A2 level according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages.
Housing assistance	Students are in charge of finding their own housing. We have a number of suggestions on our website, and student tutors are available to assist in this search.
