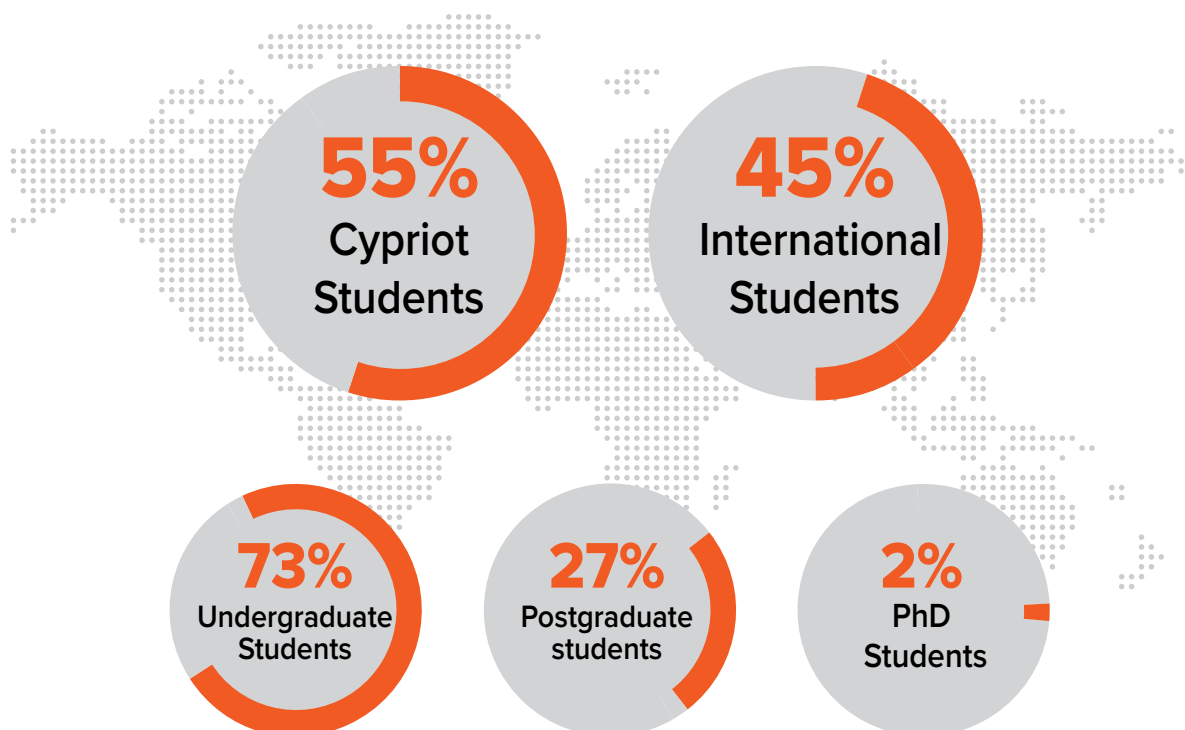

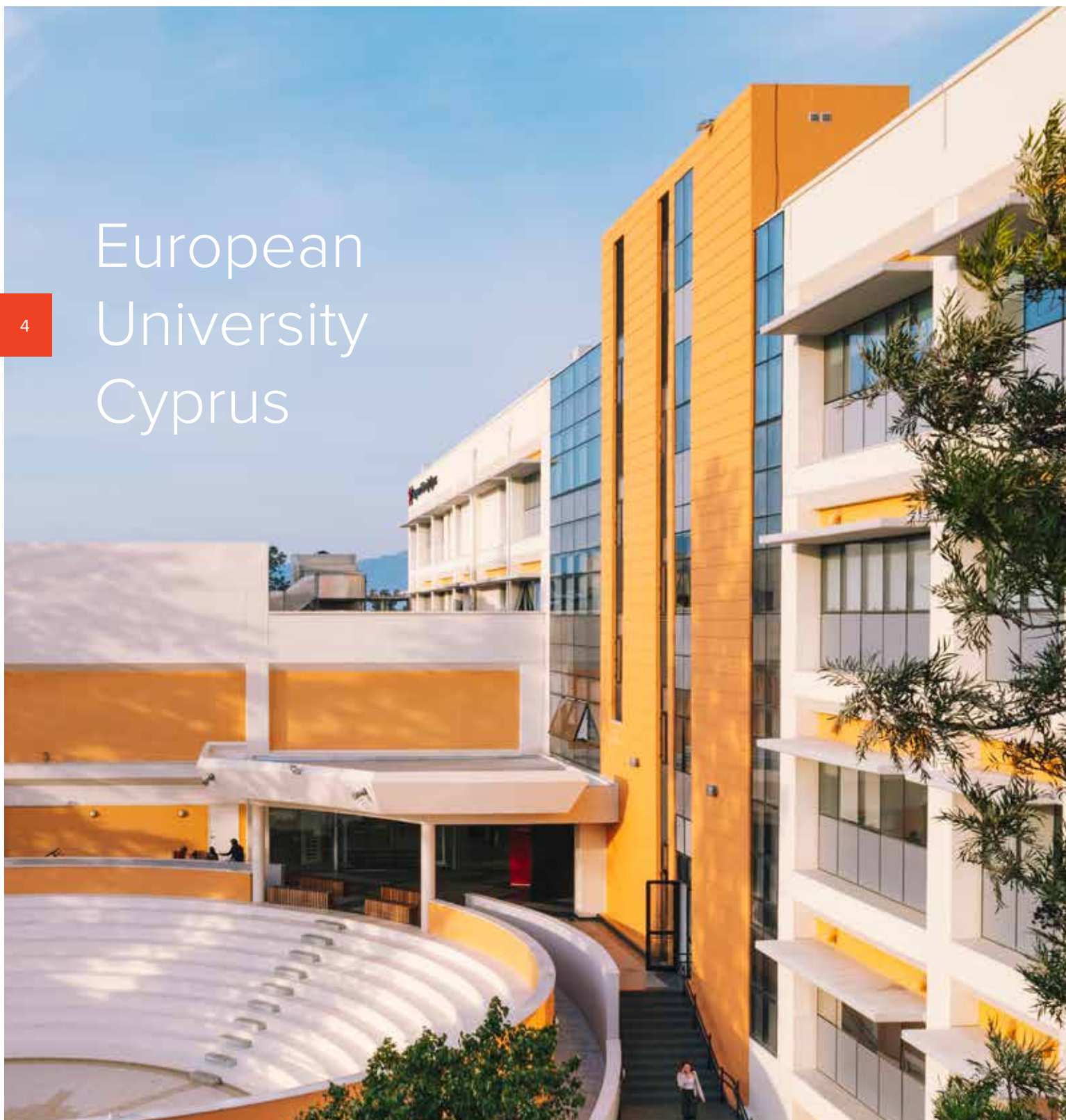

European University Cyprus is one of the leading institutions of higher education in Cyprus.

It was established as Cyprus College in 1961 and was granted university status in 2007. It boasts a student enrollment of over 6,900 in undergraduate, graduate and doctorate degree programs.

European University Cyprus has established a reputation for quality education with a sharp focus on the employability of its students, and has been recognized for its investment in high tech innovation and engagement with industry and society. Over the last decade, the university has fostered a culture of modernization that has resulted in levels of growth that have exceeded all expectations, upgrading the quality of tertiary education in Cyprus and defining a clear international orientation for the university and the country.

European University Cyprus has introduced state of the art technology and boosted the country's health sector through the establishment of the most advanced School of Medicine in the region. With the launch of the first Dentistry program in the country, the university offers the most comprehensive studies in the fields of Medicine and the Health Sciences, and is attracting academics and students from around the globe

At European University Cyprus our core values are the advancement of learning, teaching and research. Times Higher Education Impact Rankings

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European University Cyprus is ranked among the world's top 101+ universities in the 2020 Times Higher Education Impact Rankings with regard to two key sectors: Innovation, Industry & Infrastructure and Actions on Climate Change.

Using the United Nations' criteria on Sustainable Development Goals the Times Higher Education Rankings assess universities on an annual basis in a range of categories.

European University Cyprus has excelled in these two categories, in the first, for its research on industry and innovation, the number of patents and spin-off companies and its research income from industry, and, in the second, for its research on climate change, its use of energy and its preparations for dealing with the consequences of climate change.

It is worth noting that for the criteria relating to the creation of spin-off companies, the capacity to generate research income from industry and the number of students securing employment placements European University Cyprus was assessed with a perfect score 100.

This is the second year running that European University Cyprus has been listed in the top 101+ universities in these two categories.

European University Cyprus secured a momentous distinction following the assessment by QS TOP UNIVERSITIES, the independent and most authoritative university-rating tool globally.

European University Cyprus is the first University in Cyprus and Greece to be rated by QS TOP UNIVERSITIES (QS Stars™), which ranks many of the most prestigious universities in the United States, Canada and Europe, placing it among the top universities in the world on the basis of its performance across several fields.

QS Stars University Rating is used by interested parties and prospective students internationally to get a wider, but also more comprehensive, picture of an institution's qualities, looking at its administrative and academic standing assessing every aspect of a university's performance from teaching and the employability of its graduates to its facilities and social responsibility.

The QS Stars University Rating evaluates an institution against 50 different indicators and awards universities between one and five stars in a range of fields.

European University Cyprus has been assessed with the highest distinction of 5-Stars in Teaching, Facilities, Inclusiveness, Employability, Social Responsibility and Internationalisation.

The European Commission has awarded European University Cyprus one of the most prestigious international awards, recognizing its contribution to research excellence. The "HR Excellence in Research Logo", was awarded following a thorough analysis of European University Cyprus supporting environment for its scientific community conducting research. This distinction places the university among the leading 392 global academic institutions.



UI GreenMetric World Ranking

According to the 2019 International UI GreenMetric World University Rankings our university was ranked 1st among universities in Cyprus in the category of "energy and climate change" and among the 200+ best universities in the world on environmental development.

On the one hand this new international recognition affirms the university's social and environmental responsibility and, on the other, the high quality of its infrastructure and the excellence of the practices it follows on matters of environmental sensitivity and policy.

European University Cyprus ranks second, after the state University of Cyprus, and among the 400+ best sustainable universities in the world. The aim of UI GreenMetric ranking is to survey and record the current condition and policies related to Green Campus and Sustainability in universities all over the world.



U-Multirank Ranking

In the European Commission's U-Multirank 2019 rankings, (total participation of 1672 Universities), European University Cyprus is placed among the top academic institutions, performing in the fields of:

- Research (Arts Related Output - top 120)
- Knowledge Transfer (Spin off - top 162)
- Income from Continuous Development (top 150)
- International Joint Academic Publications (top 181)

In the Regional Engagement Category, the University scored 82% for Bachelor graduates working in the region and 95% for Master graduates working in the region.



The University signs Magna Charta Universitatum

European University Cyprus has been approved by the Magna Charta Observatory Council to become a signatory university to the Magna Charta Universitatum. This is a remarkable distinction as the charter codifies the principles of academic freedom and institutional autonomy setting the guideline for good governance of universities.

Breakthroughs in Pioneering Research

One of the main targets of European University Cyprus is the generation of new knowledge through the promotion of scientific research. For European University Cyprus, research constitutes the primary factor in setting the bar higher in terms of teaching and education.

With a proud history of innovative research activity across all sectors, the university has achieved research breakthroughs, for instance gaining participation in the European Social Survey-ESS, a research program that was awarded the prestigious Descartes Prize “for excellence in scientific collaborative research”. The objective of the ESS research program is to study the attitudes of public opinion in European states, as regards critical topics pertaining to policies of European integration. A comparative research, with high standards of rigor applying to all countries, it is fielded every two years with a common questionnaire for all countries. In addition, the University’s academic community has presented significant research work that has propelled the University into the international spotlight. European University Cyprus also participates in all significant European research programs and national programs alike, collaborating with leading Universities and public and private bodies for the promotion of scientific research.

“Science Shop” launched at European University Cyprus

European University Cyprus has placed Cyprus in the international and European map of “Science Shops”, with the establishment of the first “Science Shop”, one of 30 operating in Europe today. The “Science Shop” is a member of the International Network of the “Living Knowledge” International Science Shop. In Cyprus, the first “Science Shop” has been incorporated into the EUC through the PERARES European Research Program (Public Engagement with Research and Research Engagement with Society, 7th framework program). It runs in the premises of the European University Cyprus, having recourse to its labs, faculty and students. In collaboration with social groups, it consistently endeavors to offer scientific solutions to problems facing the Cyprus society and economy.



Professional Recognition

All degrees awarded by European University Cyprus are fully recognized by competent professional organizations. More particularly, the “Computer Science”, “Computer Engineering” and “Electrical and Electronic Engineering” programs are recognized by the Cyprus Scientific and Technical Chamber; the “Nursing” program by the European Commission; the “Radiodiagnostics-Radiotherapy” program by the Cyprus Council of Radiologic Technologists and Radiation Therapy Technologists; the “Nutrition and Dietetics” program by the Cyprus Council of Food Technologists, Nutritionists and Dieticians; the “Physiotherapy” program by the Cyprus Physiotherapists and Physiotherapy Establishments Registration Council; and the “Speech and Language Therapy” program by the Association of Registered Speech & Language Pathologists of Cyprus.



The Library

As the intellectual center of the campus, the European University Cyprus Library offers students physical spaces for quiet study, group project meetings, research and learning. It also provides 24/7 access to digital spaces where the European University Cyprus community can find information in an electronic format from around the world. With professional and responsive staff, the European University Cyprus library provides the highest level of resources, services and technology to support users at any time and from any place.

The Library strives to:

- Ensure that every European University Cyprus student achieves information literacy through visits, tours and instruction, developing research skills to find, evaluate and utilize information
- Provide access to information in physical and electronic format and support users to locate, organize and prioritize electronic information
- Continuously assess and improve the Library's technology, infrastructure and informational resources as a vital and dynamic part of the university's programs
- Maintain a safe, comfortable and accessible physical environment conducive to the pursuit of knowledge and exchange of ideas, operating on a convenient timetable

Currently the Library has over 47,000 titles in print form and over to 300,000 in electronic, covering all areas of study. To assist research, the Library also subscribes to a great number of databases through the single sign-on Open Athens platform. These databases provide users with access to full-text magazines, journals, newspapers, conference proceedings, company reports and many more. The library promotes the research work of the faculty through its repository, Plemochoe, which is an open access institutional repository established for the sole purpose of gathering preserving and distributing original research produced by EUC faculty and researchers.

The EUC Library is also a founding member of the Cyprus Academic Libraries Consortium (CALC).

General Admission Requirements

The criteria for admission to European University Cyprus have been set to enable the Office of Admissions to select students who have the ability to do university-level work and to place students in courses and programs appropriate to their academic strengths, in an effort to help them successfully realize their full academic potential.

Our students come from many parts of the world and bring with them a wide range of academic skills, experiences, special interests, talents and cultural backgrounds. The Office of Admissions aims to form a student body which will give the opportunity to each student to share education and grow in experience as a member of an international community.

All applicants must have completed a secondary (high) school education or twelve years of schooling or the equivalent, to be considered for admission to undergraduate study, or hold a bachelor's degree for post-graduate study.

Candidates who have successfully completed part of their studies at an accredited university may be exempted from respective courses in the program they attend at European University Cyprus, thus reducing the period of study to obtain their degrees. For the evaluation of transferred courses, candidates must submit a copy of their transcripts to the Office of Admissions.

Undergraduate Students Admission Requirements

The general admission requirement for all undergraduate programs is the successful completion of the secondary education cycle. International students will need to submit the following documents to the Office of Admissions, in electronic form to admit@euc.ac.cy, at least three months prior to the beginning of the semester in order to be considered for admission to the university and comply with Immigration regulations:

1. A completed application form together with a non-refundable fee of €52. Applicants may also apply on line at www.euc.ac.cy
2. Official copy of High School Leaving Certificate and grade marksheet, in English, with an average grade of 'C' or above
3. Proof of English language proficiency (if any)*
4. Copy of a valid passport

***Proof of English language proficiency**

Knowledge of the English language is not a requirement for admission. At European University Cyprus, applicants whose native language is not English take the university's English Placement Test (EPT) upon arrival at the university to indicate their English level and placed in appropriate courses. Applicants who have passed either the TOEFL examination with a minimum score of 550 (213 computer-based, 79 Internet-based), English IGCSE with grade 'C' or above, or IELTS with a score of 6.5 or above are exempted from the EPT. Other external exams may be accepted by the English Department as equivalent. Please consult with the Office of Admissions for more details. Candidates, whose English proficiency is not up to the university's standard, have the opportunity to take additional English Language classes according to their degree requirements.



Graduate Students Admission Requirements

The general admission requirement for graduate programs is the successful completion of a bachelor's degree at an accredited institution, or its equivalent (professional qualifications). International students will need to submit the following documents to the Office of Admissions at least three months prior to the beginning of the semester in order to be considered for admission.

1. A completed application form together with a non-refundable fee of €52. Applicants may also apply online at www.euc.ac.cy
2. Official copy of a bachelor's degree, in English, from a recognized university, with an average grade of 'C' or above, or official copies of professional qualifications
3. Official copy of academic transcript, in English
4. Official copy of High School Leaving Certificate and grade marksheet, in English
5. Proof of English language proficiency (if any)
6. One recommendation letter
7. Proof of work experience (if applicable)
8. Curriculum Vitae (CV)
9. Copy of a valid passport



PhD Students Admission Requirements

Every year, European University Cyprus announces a limited number of positions for various doctoral programs. International students will need to submit the following documents to the Office of Admissions, in electronic form to admit@euc.ac.cy, in order to be considered for a Ph.D program:

1. A completed application form together with a non-refundable fee of €52. Applicants may also apply online at www.euc.ac.cy
2. Official copies of bachelor and master degrees (or official letter verifying that the applicant has successfully completed all degree requirements)
3. Official copies of academic transcripts
4. Proof of English language proficiency (if any)
5. Copies of relevant publications (up to two)
6. One letter of recommendation from faculty members of higher academic institutions
7. Other supporting documents such as awards, distinctions, etc.
8. Curriculum Vitae (CV)
9. Copy of valid passport

All eligible applicants will be invited for an interview in Cyprus. When necessary the University will conduct interviews online. Applicants will need to produce evidence of their academic performance and credentials. Applicants will be notified of the exact date of their interview.

Payment of Fees (EU students only)

Upon receipt of an acceptance letter from the University, undergraduate students are required to submit a down payment of €1,100 and postgraduate students a down payment of €500.

Admission and Visa Requirements (Non - EU students)

All international, non-European Union students need to obtain a visa to study in Cyprus. Student visas are issued in Cyprus, a copy of which is sent to successful applicants. After receiving a letter of acceptance from the Office of Admissions, students must apply for a visa by submitting the documents listed below to the University (Office of Admissions, International Office, P.O. Box 22006, 1516, Nicosia, Cyprus) in English, at least three months prior to the beginning of the semester:

- Certified copy of relevant academic records in English
 - Undergraduate students: certified copy of High School Leaving Certificate and grade marksheet
 - Master students: certified copy of Bachelor's degree from a recognized university, or certified copies of professional qualifications
 - PhD students: certified copy of Bachelor and Master degree
- Certified copy of a valid passport, valid for a minimum of two (2) years
- Certified original letter attesting to good conduct, issued by the police authorities in the student's country of citizenship, confirming a clear criminal record. The letter of good conduct should be issued no more than 6 months before the date of submission of documents for Visa approval.
- Certified original health certificates for HIV, hepatitis B, hepatitis C, and syphilis and a chest X-ray report (for tuberculosis). Health certificates should be issued no more than 4 months before the date of submission of documents for Visa approval and must be issued only from public hospitals.
- Certified original bank letter and recent bank statement confirming that the student or sponsor (parent(s)/guardian(s)) has sufficient funds to finance the student's fees and living expenses in Cyprus. The amount indicated on the bank letter and bank statement must be equivalent to at least €7,000. The bank letter should be issued no more than 6 months before the date of submission of documents for Visa

approval whilst the bank statement must show the transactions of the last two months.

Note: Visa Requirements vary according to the country of citizenship, for further information on visa attestation procedures please contact the Office of Admissions at admit@euc.ac.cy

Payment of Fees

Upon receipt of an acceptance letter from the University, undergraduate students are required to submit a down payment of €1,100 and postgraduate students a down payment of €500.

Student visa

Your application for admission to European University Cyprus is subject to approval by the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sport and Youth and the Cyprus Migration Office. Student visas are issued in Cyprus. Upon approval, a copy of the original Entry Permit (Blue Slip), will be sent to successful applicants by the Office of Admissions.

A Temporary Residence Permit (student visa card) will be issued after students arrive at European University Cyprus and complete all necessary admission, registration and payment requirements. International students holding a student visa must be enrolled for full-time study.

Tuition fees

Tuition fees vary according to program of study and are charged per teaching hour and not the number of credits. Any balance will be set off against the next semester's fees. No refund will be given for any credit balance.

Payments for the tuition fees can be paid in monthly installments. Final adjustments to tuition fees will be made after the student registers at European University Cyprus.

A total payment of €3,000 against tuition fees should be made to the Office of Admissions (prior to sending the visa required documents) via bank transfer**, or online**. The Cyprus Migration Department will NOT accept applications for student visa if the University is unable to present evidence of payment.

An additional immigration charge of €175 for the issuance of the student visa card is payable by the student, in cash, after arrival in Cyprus.

- Document Attestation (€15)

NOTE: Always quote your Reference number or Passport Number and Name of Student when making payments. Tuition fees are expressed in euros (€), the official currency of Cyprus. Students are advised to make payments in euros.

Refund policy

- A student who fails to register because he/she has not completed the process of admission or was refused a Cyprus entry visa is entitled to a refund, provided the Office of the Registrar is notified in writing. An administrative charge of €175 will be deducted, covering visa and bank expenses.
- A student who fails to register and does not enter Cyprus, even though an entry visa was issued, is entitled to a refund provided the Office of the Registrar is notified in writing. An administrative charge of €175 will be deducted, covering visa and bank expenses, as well as the International Student Guarantee of €342.
- A student who fails to register but does enter Cyprus is entitled to a refund, provided the Office of the Registrar is notified in writing. An administrative charge of €175 will be deducted, covering visa, bank, and other expenses, as well as the International Student Guarantee of €342.

Arrival checklist

When entering Cyprus (Larnaca or Paphos International Airport) all international students should also have the following with them, to ensure entry to the country:

1. The original (or copy) Entry Permit – Blue Slip, issued by the Migration Authorities of Cyprus
2. The receipts (or copies) indicating total payments of visa and registration/tuition fees to European University Cyprus
3. Official bank receipts from the bank in your country to prove the transfer of payment to the university
4. Cash in hand of at least Euro €2,000 to cover personal expenses (meals, books, accommodation, etc)
5. Acceptance letter from the Office of Admissions
6. A valid passport

Accommodation and Cost of Living

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The student accommodation units, Unihalls Trinity, are located only minutes away from campus and are designed to offer students high quality living spaces with peripheral services and amenities at their doorstep. The brand new Unihalls Trinity complex will provide housing to 228 students in smartly planned, modern and elegant studios and one-bedroom flats, all fully furnished with large wardrobes, kitchens, en-suite bathrooms and balconies to enjoy stunning views of the city. The weekly rent ranges from €117 to €144 depending on the choice of flat. The costs of utilities are included in the rent.

Living in university accommodation allows you not only to have a clean and safe flat within walking distance of the campus and its facilities, but also to enjoy the social and academic benefits of living with other students. Purpose-built with student life at its heart, the Unihalls Trinity complex offers students social spaces to relax and get together with friends including a cafeteria and fitness center, and other convenient services including laundry rooms with washing machines and dryers, high speed internet, car parking, bike storage and an arrival package with essential housewares.

The dedicated staff of the Housing Office will guide you to get the best of student accommodation that meets your personal needs and standards. Accommodation is available at anytime, subject to availability, but the busiest hunting months are normally June - September.

Additionally, the Housing Office can provide information about other organize accommodation units and has a list of private apartments/houses for rent very close to campus. Typically, the rent for a one-bedroom apartment is usually between €450 to €600 a month, two-bedroom is between €500 to €650 a month, while the rent for a three-bedroom apartment is between €600 to €750 a month. The cost of living in Nicosia depends on the lifestyle of each individual. For the average student, it is calculated between €450 to €550 a month.

On the University campus a cafeteria-restaurant, offers meals and snacks at regulated prices. The cafeteria-restaurant is open daily from 8:00am - 9:00pm except Saturday and Sunday.

Employability

The Center is an active member of the International Association for the Exchange of Students for Technical Experience IAESTE.

Cyprus Annual Medical Students Meeting

To promote learning, interaction and communication among medical students, European University Cyprus hosts the Cyprus Annual Medical Students Meeting (CAMESM) each spring on campus. This meeting allows medical students to gain exposure to high-level research and discussion of clinical practice in an enriching scientific setting.

Keynote speakers have included professors of international reputation and recognition presenting from such diverse areas as the future of transplant surgery to the biological basis of stress management. Eminent educators, distinguished scientists and medical students themselves present on topics of interest to medical and health sciences students during plenary sessions and workshops.

Recent topics have included clinical training, career opportunities/pathways, medical research, clinical specialization, industrial applications, volunteer and not-for-profit service opportunities, medical ethics, medical association directives and current and future trends in the profession.

CAMESM is well attended by international academicians and professionals as well as local healthcare officials, including the Pancyprrian Medical Association, the Cyprus Medical Students Association, the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sport and Youth representatives.

First prize at the Researcher's Night

The School of Medicine was awarded 1st prize for "Best Activity" during the Researcher's Night 2017. The project "Exploring the Brain" aimed to outreach the public and motivate their interest into discovering the structure and function of the human brain.

European University Cyprus participates annually at the European Researcher's Night. The active participation of European University Cyprus students, as well as researchers and academic staff, promotes diversity through various research disciplines and highlights the impact of research on people's daily life. This year, European University Cyprus members presented ten different research activities, demonstrating the contribution of research to society and its value in everyday life. More than 8,000 people visit the European Researcher's event.

First Prize Pancyprrian Educational Robotic Olympiad

The Department of Computer Science & Engineering of European University Cyprus won First place for the second consecutive year in the 4th Pancyprrian Educational Robotic Olympiad. The university's team won the University Students category for the implementation of a robotic system on Bowling Simulation. The European University Cyprus winning team represented Cyprus in the World Educational Robotics Olympiad in December 2017 in India, securing the 20th position among 52 universities that attended the event.

'Motion Vibes' an Innovative Education Project

An outstanding innovative program for hearing impaired students takes place only at European University Cyprus. "Motion Vibes" is a unique innovative project – the only one of its kind – through which hearing impaired students can add sound to the moving image.

The project was developed and implemented by Ms. Demetra Englezou, 3D Design and Animation Instructor with students' contribution, as part of the activities of the Cultural Studies and Contemporary Arts Laboratory. The "Motion Vibes" is based entirely on the relationship between kinesiology and sound using vibrations. The students, using apps (applications) with a vibration output depending on the ripples of the music, can "feel" the sound and synchronize it to the moving image. The "Motion Vibes": An Educational Project, was presented at the Conference Motion Design Education Summit in Dublin.

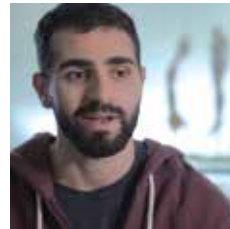

The School of Business Administration



The School of Business Administration was the first Business School in Cyprus. Today, graduates of the School hold managerial positions in both the public and private sectors. It is the first school to establish the Start-Up Academy to promote innovation and start-up projects.

The development of the School's programs of study has been consistent with the emergence of Cyprus as a center for services, which made managers trained in Management, Marketing and Hotel Management highly sought after. The School's programs have been drawn up in parallel to the development of Economics both in Cyprus and internationally, in order to always meet the needs and demands of contemporary economy and society. The faculty's high scientific stature reflects the quality of studies and rightly preserves the School of Business Administration of European University Cyprus in the international spotlight.

Graduates with a degree in Accounting may be exempted from 9 out of 13 courses of the ACCA (Association of Certified Chartered Accountants) and 12 out of 15 courses of the ICAEW (Institute of Chartered Accountants in England and Wales).

The Business Studies program encompasses a wide range of subjects, enabling students to design a flexible program of study with up to three areas of concentration. The degree provides students with practical business skills in accounting, finance, human resource management, strategy, change-management, and quantitative and qualitative tools of analysis, as well as offering insight into different business sectors.

The Master of Business Administration offers a rigorous training across the field of management, including strategy, marketing, information management, leadership, team-building, innovation, human resources, finance, and change management. The program equips graduates to successfully perform in senior management positions and strengthens qualitative and quantitative analytical skills.

The School of Humanities, Social and Education Sciences

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The School consists of the Department of Arts, Department of Education, Department of Humanities and Department of Social and Behavioral Sciences.

The Department of Arts offers a notable Music program, its faculty and students participating in the University's Symphonic Band and/or Choir, well-liked contributors to Nicosia's calendar of cultural events. Students may choose between Music Pedagogy or Music Performance courses, whilst Elective Courses span a wide range of topics, including jazz.

The Department of Arts is organising the International Motion Festival. It is the first of its kind in Cyprus, the broader Mediterranean and the Middle East region. It is undoubtedly for these reasons that the EU (EFA- European Festivals Association) has awarded the International Motion Festival the EFFE label, three times in a row, including it among the European festivals "that stand for artistic quality and have a significant impact on the local, national and international level".



Graphic Arts teachers infuse their teaching methods with imagination, creativity and originality, training students to work with images and texts in graphic design companies, publishing houses or advertising firms. In a growing industry that requires a variety of different types of visual designs, skilled graphic designers are highly sought after either as employees or self-employed professionals.

The Department of Arts has developed an innovative educational program, the Motion Vibes, which helps hearing impaired students to understand the emotional value of music. Motion vibes is based entirely on the relation between kinesiology and sound using vibrations which enables students to add sound in their animation graphics using images. The 3D and Animation instructor Ms Demetra Englezou who developed this project, presented it at the Motion Design Education Summit in Dublin.

Scholars of the Psychology program cover a wide span of fields relevant to psychology, such as developmental difficulties, psychopathology, learning difficulties, counselling etc.



The scientific and teaching personnel of this particular discipline, just as that of the entire School, maintains active participation in research pertaining to the field's requirements and objectives.

Furthermore KEPSYPA was established to provide psychological services (Prevention-Assessment-Therapy) to the community of European University Cyprus. The Center offers professional psychological services to all students and staff, free of charge.

The Department has been the first to introduce a doctoral degree in Education Sciences, with a focus on Special (Inclusive) Education or Education Management Leadership.

European University Cyprus boasts the most fully-fledged Departments of Health and Life Sciences in Cyprus, including programs in Pharmacy, Radiodiagnostics-Radiotherapy, Sports Science and Physical Education, Biological Sciences, Biomedical Sciences, Nutrition and Dietetics, Occupational Therapy, Nursing and Physiotherapy.

The parallel operation of the School of Medicine at the University provides extra impetus to the Pharmacy program in terms of infrastructure and lab equipment, academic personnel, interdisciplinary support, knowhow, research, prestige and recognition.

The Nursing degree (BSc in General Nursing) has been recognized by the European Commission as an approved European program according to the EU Directive on the “Recognition of Professional Qualifications”, which allows qualified nurses to carry out their profession in all EU countries.

Students pursuing “Speech and Language Therapy” are trained at the University’s Speech, Language and Hearing Clinic under the direct supervision of experienced Speech Pathologists. The School of Sciences of European University Cyprus is the only School in Cyprus running its own Clinic.

The School of Law at European University Cyprus is the first and to this day the only fully-fledged Law School in Cyprus, accredited by The Cyprus Agency of Quality Assurance and Accreditation (DI.P.A.E.) and the Ministry of Education and Culture of the Republic of Cyprus.

The School's Law Degrees are officially recognized by the Legal Council of the Republic with the accreditation officially posted on the website of the Legal Council of the Republic of Cyprus. Having amassed the required credit units for obtaining a degree, graduates of the Faculty of Law may submit their degree to the Law Office of the Republic and register as trainee lawyers with the Cyprus Bar Association.

The School of Law is recognised - by a decision of DOATAP, the Hellenic National Academic Recognition Information Centre - as equivalent and corresponding to the Law Schools of Greek Universities and its degrees carry the full academic and professional rights as those of the degrees of Greek universities.

Law Students participate in Erasmus which refers to the mobility of students in universities of the EU member countries. The School of Law has signed Erasmus mobility agreements with the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens, the Democritus University of Thrace and the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki.

European University Cyprus has signed a memorandum of cooperation with the Law School of the University of Athens, Democritus University of Thrace, the European Public Law Organization and the Institute for Constitutional Studies of the University of Athens.

As an indication of the School of Law's widening regional reach and its growing prestige, former Greek President Prokopis Pavlopoulos in his official visit to Cyprus in March 2015 was awarded an honorary degree by European University Cyprus. President Pavlopoulos in his previous capacity as Professor of Law at the University of Athens had taught and participated in workshops and seminars organised by the School of Law of European University Cyprus.

The School of Medicine

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European University Cyprus School of Medicine has been pivotal to accomplishing the University's aim to play a prominent role in the country as a regional provider of medical education at the highest international standards.

The School of Medicine is structured according to EU directives and international standards, and was founded in collaboration with distinguished international scholars from Cyprus and abroad.

Characterised by a dynamic learning environment, the School of Medicine ensures that students graduate with the necessary competencies in knowledge, skills and professionalism that are required of today's clinicians, not only to practice medicine globally, but also to become leaders in healthcare and medical research.

The School has established an international network for summer externships for practical training (clinical and research) of its students with over 60 placements in institutions, Universities and hospitals, in over 10 different countries around the world.

The School of Medicine is an official host for the Harvard T.H. Chan School of Public Health Executive and Continuing Professional Education course entitled "Principles and Practice of Clinical Research" (PPCR). The PPCR certificate course is taught online by the faculty of the Harvard T.H. Chan School of Public Health.

World Federation for Medical Education (WFME)

By ensuring the highest scientific and ethical standards in medical education, the EUC School of Medicine was accredited through the rigorous standards and procedures of the World Federation for Medical Education (WFME), ensuring the following:

Global Mark of Recognition

The EUC Medical Education Program is fully compliant with globally accepted criteria endorsed by the World Health Organization, World Medical Association and International Association of Medical Regulatory Authorities.

ECFMG Eligibility for Medical Graduates

EUC School of Medicine meets all requirements for the Educational Commission for Foreign Medical Graduates (ECFMG) Certification required to study or work in the United States or Canada.

With this approval, students and graduates of the EUC School of Medicine can apply to ECFMG to take the US Medical Licensing Examination (USMLE) for medical licensure in the US. ECFMG certification is required to evaluate the qualifications of physicians wishing to pursue postgraduate studies to acquire specialization in the United States, as well as to be licensed to practice medicine in the United States.



Doctor of Medicine Program

The School of Medicine at European University Cyprus has a competency-based integrated-spiral curriculum and employs a variety of teaching-learning methods. These include lectures, problem-based learning, skill-based learning, wet-labs, independent learning, clinical skills sessions, virtual learning and clinical training with patient contact at public and private hospitals in Cyprus.

The School of Medicine is a dynamic learning environment, which enables students to develop the necessary skills and attributes required to practice medicine. The curriculum is skilled-based and students are exposed to clinical work and clinical relevance starting from the first year of study. This hands-on, practical approach is maintained throughout the six years of the course of study.

Teaching is conducted in English, with a minimum work load of 360 ECTS of the education and training required to complete the Bachelor of Medicine Degree over six years. No 'premedical' coursework is required as the program of study provides an all-inclusive, full basic sciences thematic unit.

The training of the students is oriented to the preparation of up-to-date, competent, ethical and fully adaptable medical doctors with the resourcefulness necessary to face inevitable changes in the field that develop over time. The School focuses on the students' acquisition of the most efficient clinical skills and on the implementation of professional ethics in the field of medicine.

Dentistry Program

The Bachelor of Dental Surgery at European University Cyprus offers a modern curriculum based on the highest European and North American dental education standards.

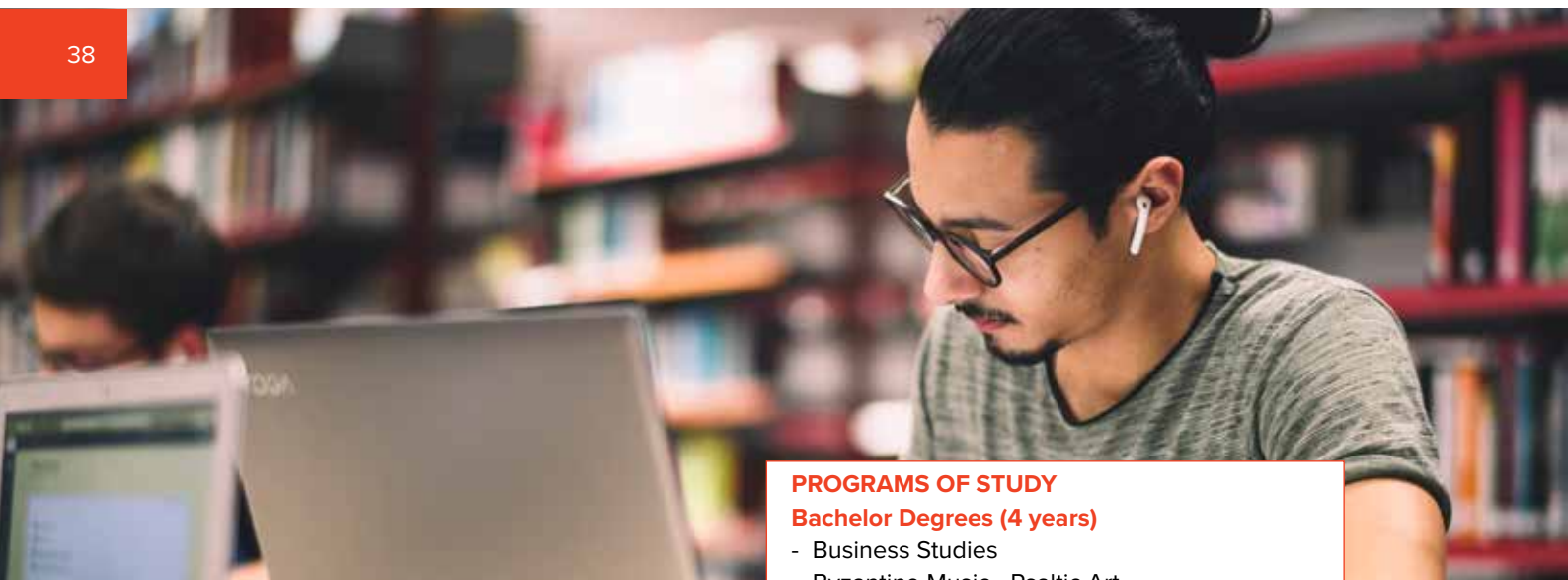
The program follows the guidelines concerning the Profile and Competences for the Graduating European Dentist, which was approved by the Association of Dental Education in Europe (ADEE). The Department of Dentistry of the School of Medicine of European University Cyprus is a full member of ADEE, ensuring the compatibility and continuous updating of the curriculum so that graduates will acquire the desired level of qualifications and skills.

Pre-clinical and clinical dental training takes place in state-of-the-art facilities and is taught by highly qualified academic faculty. Labs include Haptic Dental Simulators, the Digital Dentistry and Digital Planning Lab, the Anatomy Lab, the Dental Simulation Lab and the Dental Clinic. Technology enhanced learning utilizes Haptic and Dental radiology simulators, which provide students with a process-based, comprehensive and hands-on learning experience enabling them to perform procedures on patients following extensive practice.

Clinical training is performed at the privately-owned University Dental Clinic, aiming at the direct association of theoretical education with practical training.

The Distance Education Unit

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The Unit was established in 2013 and has grown rapidly, offering easy access to education opportunities to a wide number of students and/or professionals who are not able to attend a face-to-face program of study, due to geographical, professional, family or other constraints. By responding to a growing social need for learning through alternative education programs, the Distance Education Unit helps promote equal opportunity in education.

The Distance Education Unit implements a concrete specialized and integrated pedagogical model, which is adjusted to the needs, special characteristics and legislation of the Hellenic region (Greece and Cyprus); combining online teaching with an obligatory (written) final examination.

The whole teaching and learning process takes place on a virtual campus, where the Blackboard e-learning platform is used. More specifically, the Distance Education Unit of the European University Cyprus model revolves around a single central element: the learner and facilitating his/her learning process towards knowledge. The success of this model lays in perfectly designing the learning activities, which are shaped by the three key elements that are always present in the educational process, even with a different level of intensity and participation each time.

Important Collaborations

The Distance Education Unit of the European University Cyprus has signed important memoranda of collaboration with high profile Open Universities in Cyprus and abroad. More specifically, a memorandum of collaboration was signed with the Hellenic Open University, aiming in the quality advancement of the education services offered, with particular emphasis given on joint programs of study.



The signing of the memorandum signifies the common vision that the two academic institutions share, to promote, not only joint programs of study and modern scientific developments, but also respond to the needs of the Greek and Cypriot society, respectively.

Students of Distance Education Programs of Study

The students of the distance education programs of study originate from a variety of disciplines. However, a common feature among them is their great academic qualifications and their trust in the educational model of distance education. The Distance Education Unit counts students mainly from Greece and Cyprus, Europe in general, as well as countries from the rest of the world.
