➤ Application Process

Applicants are required to select full-time PhD programmes of the UM. They should submit application for the MPDS or PhD assistantship simultaneously when submitting application for admission.

➤ Admission Requirements

Doctoral Degree Programmes:

· General Entry (for Master's Degree Holders)

Possess a Master's degree or academic background recognized as equivalent by the University of Macau.

Accelerated Entry (for Master's Students)

Have been registered in a Master's Programme at the University of Macau for at least one year.

Have successfully finished the coursework part with outstanding performance and have demonstrated strong research ability.

· Direct Entry (for Bachelor's Degree Holders)

Possess a Bachelor's degree with outstanding performance and have demonstrated strong research ability.

Master's Degree Programmes:

- Hold a Bachelor's degree or equivalents.
- Achieved the equivalent* of an overall result of Grade C+ or better in the Bachelor's degree studies (except for the Faculty of Law).
- · Fulfil the language proficiency requirement of the specific programme.
- · At least 2 years full-time work experience for admission to MBA.
- Note: The equivalent means 2.3 on the 4.0 GPA scale, 14 on the 20-point scale or 70 out of 100.

➤ English Requirements

Applicants who received their Bachelor's / Master's degree from a university where the medium of instruction was not English are required to provide one of the following as proof of English proficiency:

- A TOEFL* score of 550 (paper-based examination)/ 80 (Internet-based examination); or
- An IELTS* overall score of 6.0 or above with no sub-score lower than 5.5; or
- A Level 6 of the College English Test (CET) score of 430 (only applicable to Master's degree programmes and some of the PhD programmes); or
- Passed the Level 4 or Level 8 of the Test for English Majors (TEM) (only applicable to Master's degree programmes).
- * Note: TOEFL and IELTS scores are valid for two years from the test date.
