

Entry Scholarships ²

PolyU offers generous scholarships to students who excel in academic and non-academic areas. Application is NOT required for entry scholarships. All eligible applicants will be automatically considered.

Academic: A maximum amount of HK\$225,000 / US\$28,846 per annum (i.e., 100% tuition fee + living allowance)

Non-Academic (Special Talents Admission and Recognition Scheme [STARS]): A maximum amount of **HK\$225,000** / **US\$28,846** *per annum* (i.e., 100% tuition fee + living allowance)

Cultural Ambassador Scholarship:

A maximum of HK\$40,000 / US\$5,128 per annum
