Affordable study

Gaining a postgraduate qualification doesn't have to mean sacrificing too much time or money. UOW offers a range of fee support options, giving you more reason to start working towards your next promotion, pay rise or career change.

Fee support options

COMMONWEALTH SUPPORTED PLACES (CSP)

Many UOW courses have Commonwealth supported places (CSPs) for eligible students.

A CSP is where the Australian Government contributes up to three quarters of your total tuition fee, with the remainder paid by the student (known as the student contribution). If you are enrolled in a CSP, you may be eligible for a HECS-HELP loan to defer all or part of your student contribution.

Refer to studyassist.gov.au for the most up-to-date information about CSPs and HECS-HELP loans.

FULL-FEE PAYING PLACES (FFPP)

Courses without Commonwealth supported places are considered full-fee paying places (FFPP), where the Australian Government does not contribute towards the cost of your studies. You may be eligible to access a FEE-HELP loan to cover part of or all of your tuition fees.

Check studyassist.gov.au for the most up-to-date information. Eligible students who can demonstrate financial disadvantage or meet equity-based criteria can apply for a limited number of Commonwealth supported places for ordinarily FFPP courses.

FEE SUPPORT FAQS

WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR A COMMONWEALTH SUPPORTED PLACE?

To be eligible for a CSP you must be an Australian or New Zealand citizen or the holder of a permanent visa, and meet the criteria outlined at studyassist.gov.au

ARE THERE CSPs BASED ON EQUITY?

UOW offers a small number of Commonwealth supported places in full fee paying courses for students who can demonstrate financial disadvantage and/or meet equity-based criteria. Students who meet this criteria may also be eligible to apply for HECS-HELP.

You will need to complete an application for a Commonwealth supported place in a fee-paying postgraduate course.

HOW DO I PAY FOR MY COURSE?

Pay later: Defer part or all of your fees by accessing a FEE-HELP or, HECS-HELP loan (for eligible students).

Pay now: Pay your fees or student contribution upfront by the census date. If you make an upfront payment of \$500 or more on your HECS-HELP loan you will receive a 10 per cent discount.

Study options

UOW coursework programs are designed to develop practical and relevant skills from a range of specialisations that are driven by the current needs of industry.

Similar to undergraduate study, postgraduate coursework students engage with content for each of their subjects either through our online learning systems or in person – depending on the subject and course. Assessments are based on a combination of written assignments, presentations, exams and practical exercises. Some coursework degrees also offer the option to complete a research project. Diverse course delivery options allow many students to complete their postgraduate studies while still working full-time.

MASTER'S BY COURSEWORK

1, 1.5 OR 2 YEARS FULL-TIME OR PART-TIME EQUIVALENT

If you have successfully completed an undergraduate degree in a related area, you may be eligible for credit for prior learning into a range of master's qualifications. This allows you to complete the master's program in one year. All other master's degrees can be completed between 1.5 – 2 years or part-time equivalent.

A UOW master's degree can help you gain that promotion, start your specialist career, or change career paths completely. Admission normally requires a recognised bachelor's degree in a related area. However, there are exceptions. For details see coursefinder.uow.edu.au
