ISCTE-IUL provides its students with an ideal atmosphere for studying and socialising. The physical and technological facilities on campus are modern and functional, with Wi-Fi throughout. In addition to auditoriums and classrooms, there are also group study rooms. The campus has five cafés, two restaurants and plenty of places to chill out.

There are 2 underground stations within 2 minutes' walk and 2 bus stops located within the campus where major routes cross. An intermodal railway station is 5 minutes' walk away. The airport is 10 minutes drive from ISCTE-IUL and there is plenty of parking near the campus.

UNIVERSITY HALL OF RESIDENCE

The Professor José Pinto Peixoto Hall of Residence meets the needs of visiting students and lecturers. It is located in the 16th-century Santos-o-Novo Monastery, which is a national monument. It stands on a hill overlooking the River Tagus in the eastern part of Lisbon and commands a magnificent view. It is located near Santa Apolónia Railway Station in the traditional Alfama neighbourhood, Terreiro do Paço and more modern residential, shopping and service areas such as Parque das Nações.
