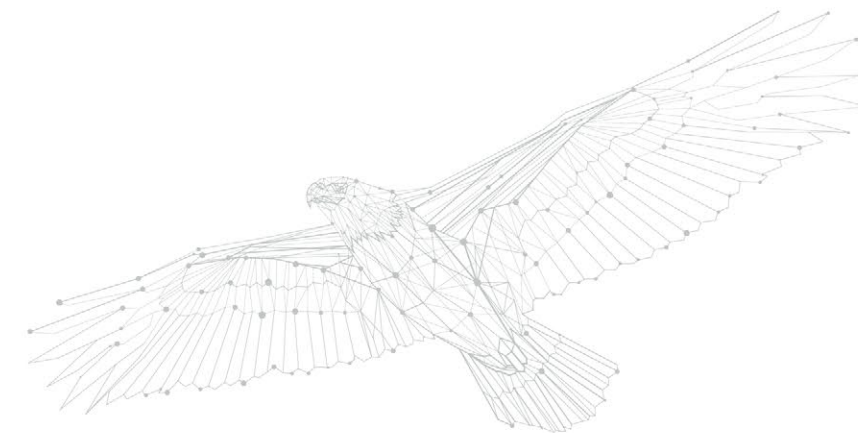

PNU Founding Story



Committed to becoming a global research-oriented university

Pusan National University was the first comprehensive national university in the Republic of Korea, established through the donations of local citizens on May 15, 1946.

As a leader on the path to industrialization and democratization, the university has served as a regional hub institution that has remained actively engaged in the great journey of Korean modern history.

Marking its 72nd anniversary in 2018, PNU will take another step towards becoming a global research-oriented university.



Established with the love and donation of local citizens

In 1945, Korea gained its independence, but had functional national institutions. Despite these poor conditions, there was great passion to foster the human resources that would later lead the country. Educational policies before the establishment of the official Korean Government were determined by the US army government. Two-year preparatory courses for higher education began to transform into four-year degree programs. At the time, Gyeongsangnam-do authorities focused their energies on establishing a national university. To this end, the Okcheonsa (Temple) in Goseong donated a plot of land approximately 430,280m² in size (valued at KRW 5,000,000) to the university foundation, and residents and businesses collectively donated a total of nearly KRW 10,329,000. Most of the money was used to fund the establishment of Korea's first national university, while the rest was allocated to procuring books to fill the new university library.



Korea's first comprehensive national university launched on May 15, 1946

The preparatory work for the university foundation was completed by the Gyeongsangnam-do Academic Division Director, In-Ku Yun. On May 15, 1946, In-Ku Yun and the School Affairs Advisor, Lieutenant Eddy, worked with the relevant agencies to obtain final approval from the education ministries of Korea and the United States for the establishment of PNU. Its original name was Pusan National College, and it opened with two departments: Humanities and Maritime Affairs. With an initial faculty similar to a college today, Article 2 of the university law of March 7, 1946 states that a comprehensive university can be organized with two or more faculties if it includes faculties from both the humanities and the natural sciences. On July 1948, the official name was changed to Pusan National University; and two faculties became the Schools of Humanities and Fisheries. Later, the schools were divided into two independent colleges, Pusan National Fisheries College and Pusan National College.



First PNU president Yun's foundational philosophy: Truth, Freedom and Service

In April 3, 1953, PNU took a leap forward with the establishment of a six-college system, which included the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences, the College of Law, the College of Commerce, the College of Pharmacy, and the College of Medicine. The Decree on the Establishment of National Schools was amended on September 15, 1953. The 'Decree on the Establishment of Pusan National University' was promulgated by Korean Presidential Order, and PNU was formally launched as Korea's first national university. On November 26, Dr. Yun was appointed as the first president of the university.



U.S. Military Command General Richard Whitcomb's full support for PNU foundation

PNU's first president, In-Ku Yun, faced difficulties finding a site after launching Korea's first national university in 1946. He met with U.S. Army general Richard Whitcomb, who was commander of the UN Forces Military Command in Busan at the time. Dr. Yun showed him the bell-shaped campus layout that he had designed. The president also presented his vision and dreams for education in Korea and asked for American assistance. General Whitcomb was moved by President Yun's passion and dedication. He worked to persuade the president of South Korea, Syng-Man Rhee, and the governor of Gyeongsangnam-do to procure a site spanning across more than 1.65 million square meters in the Jangjeon-dong neighborhood in the district of Geumjeong-gu, Busan. After successfully acquiring this land free of charge, General Whitcomb had the Korean Civil Aid Corporation (KCAC) program assist with construction of the new campus facilities. The U.S. Corps of Engineers was mobilized to construct road connections between Oncheon-dong and PNU.



Fulfilling the dreams and visions of the next 100 years based on its 72 year history and traditions

PNU procured the site for the main campus on an area of 1.65 million square meters of land on the eastern skirt of Geumjeong Mountain in early 1954, and in December of that same year, the Hyowon Building construction ceremony was held to commemorate the 'Age of the Hyowon Campus'. The Saebyeokbeol Hyowon Campus came to exemplify the university motto: Truth, Freedom and Service, by serving as a permanent cradle of higher education and research. Based on its proud traditions and history, PNU is making an energetic leap to the top tier of world universities.

Desire spread like wildfire to nurture talents and restore the country during a turbulent political situation right after liberation from Japanese colonial rule. Responding to this desire, Pusan National University was launched through the efforts of In-Ku Yun, the first president of Pusan National University, who was then chief of academic affairs for South Gyeongsang Province, and funded by community contributions.

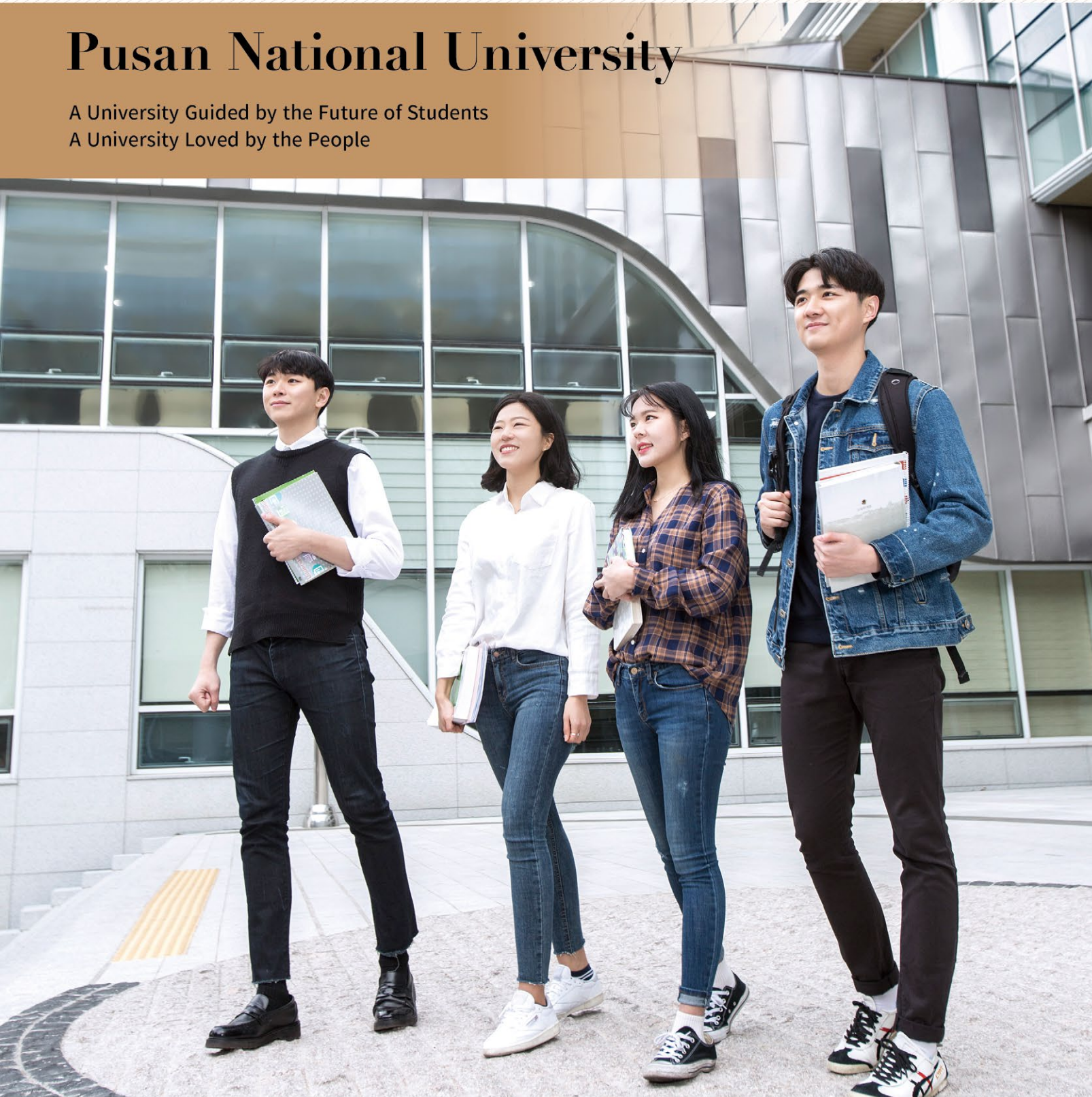

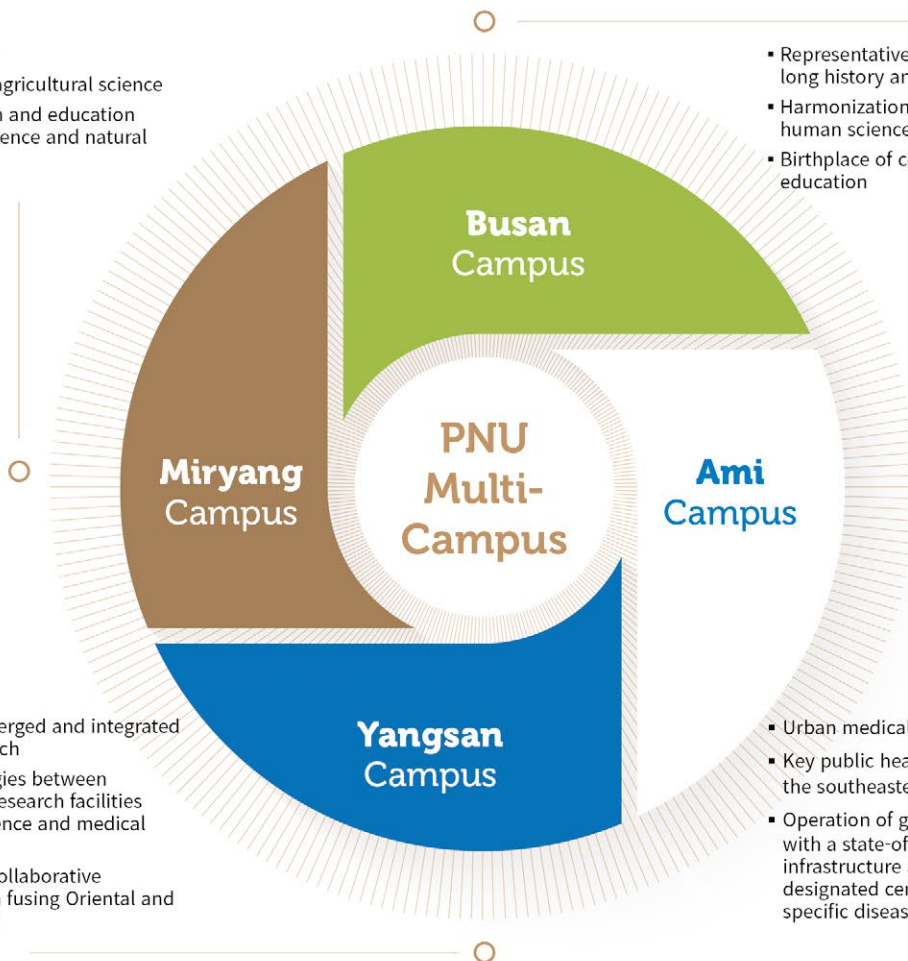


The Power of Integration and Growth Establishment of Four Regionally-specialized Campuses

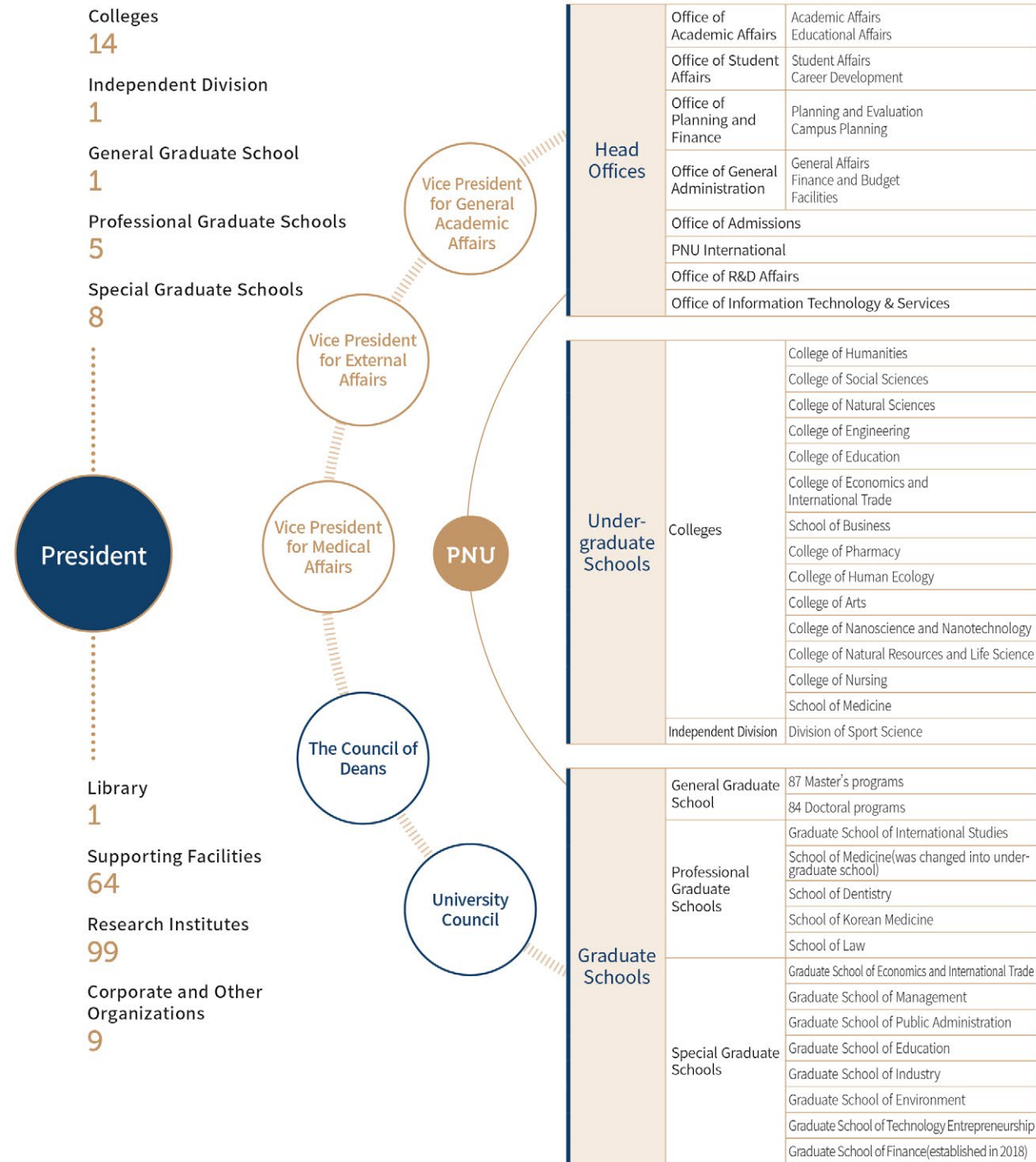

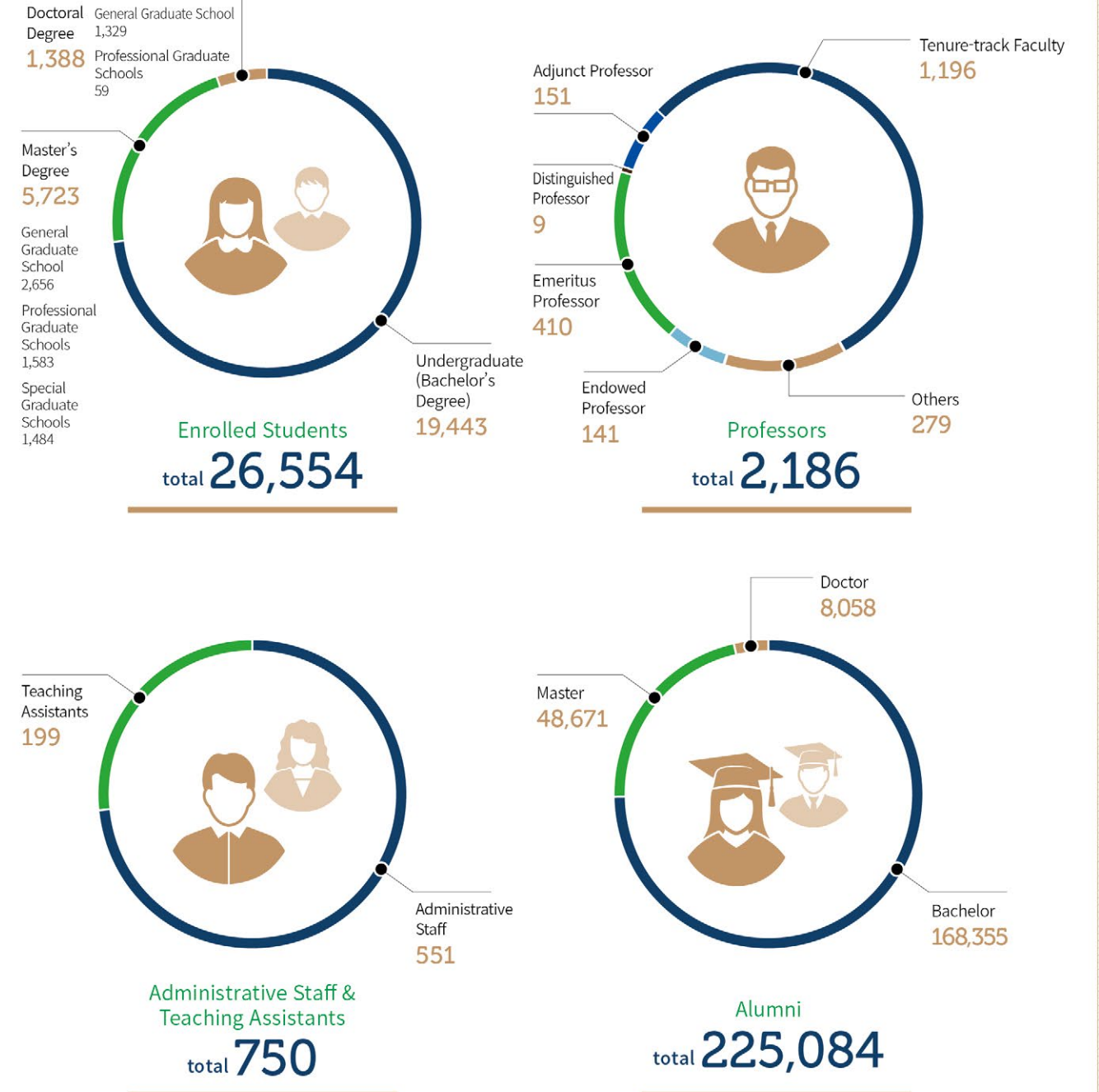

Fruit of Our Efforts of Sweat and Passion

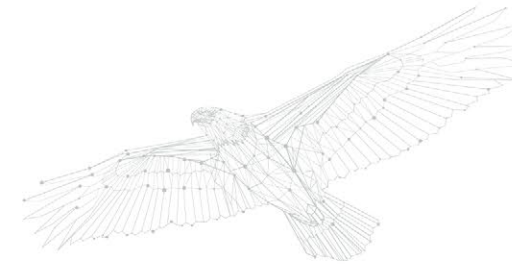
Pusan National University, accredited on May 15, 1946 as a comprehensive national university, recruited first-year students for its preparatory courses offered by the faculties of Fisheries and the Humanities. At the time, a faculty is equivalent to a college today.

In 1953, PNU paved the way to a great leap forward with the development of its six-college system, including the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences, the College of Law, the College of Commerce, the College of Pharmacy, and the College of Medicine.

Now, PNU is establishing itself as a regional hub university that leads the developments of within the southeastern region with its system of 14 colleges, 1 independent faculty, and 103 departments (majors).

With continuous innovation, PNU was ranked best national university in the 2017 Chosun Ilbo, and QS Asian College Rankings, and was placed in the Top 200 in the 2017 QS World College Rankings in six fields: Chemical Engineering, Mechanical/Aeronautical Engineering, Architecture, and Civil Engineering. In addition, the university was placed first in Regional University Graduate Employment Rankings (93.4%) and in Korea's 'University Social Responsibility Index'.

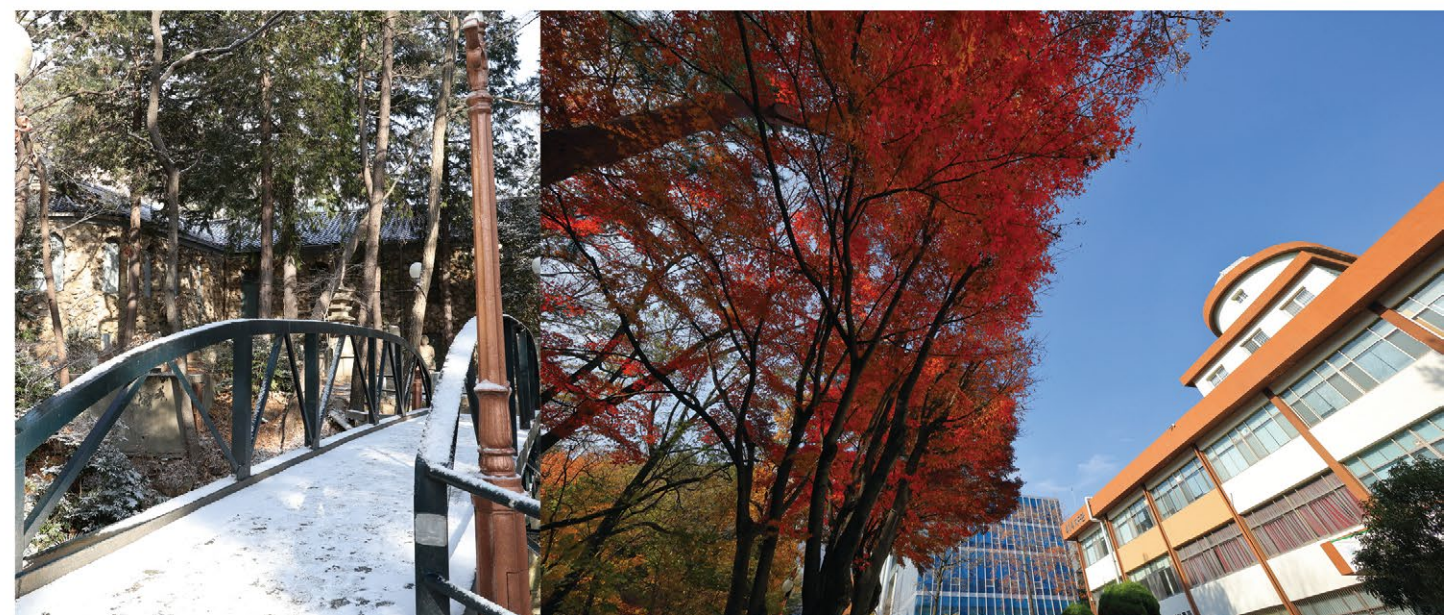
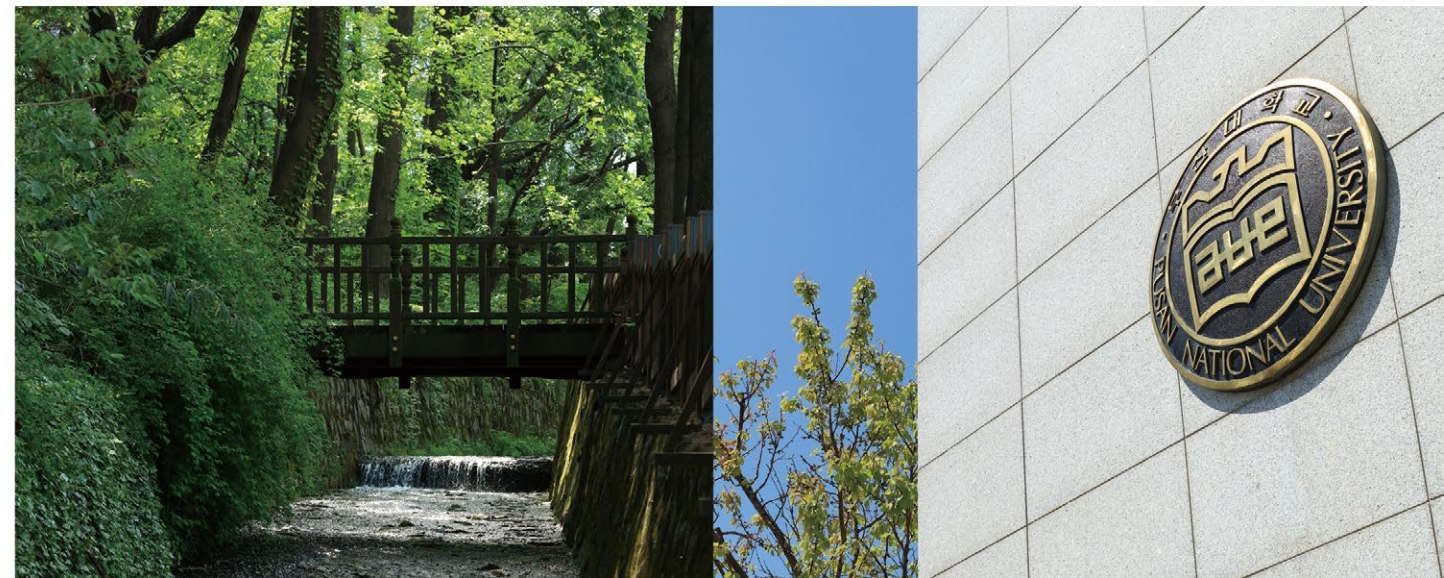

Global Research-oriented Graduate Schools

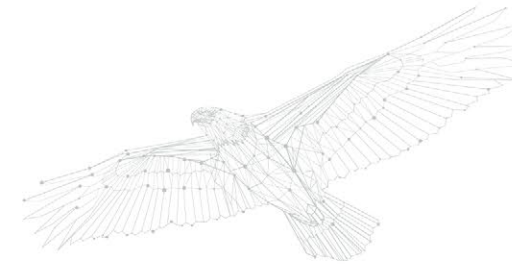
In 1954, 12 departments offered the first admissions test and selected 21 students when the Graduate School was initially organized.

Starting with the Graduate School of Management in 1969, the Graduate School of Public Administration in 1972, the Graduate School of Education(1975), the Graduate School of Industry (1982), the Graduate School of Environment(1989), the Graduate School of Economics and International Trade (2010) and the Graduate School of Technology and Entrepreneurship(2014), Graduate School of Finance(2018) were established as special graduate schools.

PNU's multi-campus system has been guided by long-term development plans, including merger with Miryang National University in 2006, and this has brought about outstanding changes in the university's graduate school education. PNU's graduate schools took a new step to meet contemporary challenges by pursuing a vision to become a new hub of research based on convergence in biomedical science, by cultivating the international experts need in this era of globalization, raising professional legal profession with global competitiveness, especially through the introduction of PNU's professional graduate schools, such as the Graduate Schools of Medicine, Dentistry, Oriental Medicine, International Studies, and Law.

PNU has various master and doctoral degree programs in 1 General Graduate School. It also operates 5 Professional Graduate Schools (School of Medicine was changed into Undergraduate School in 2017) and 8 Special Graduate Schools. The aim of these schools is to foster global leaders.

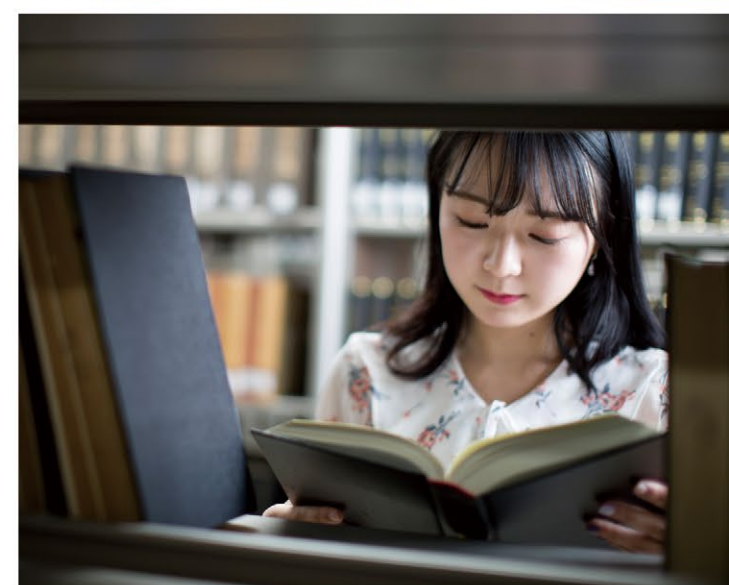

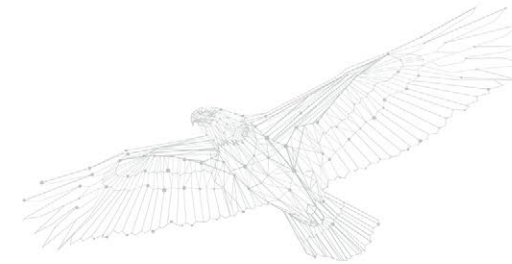


PNU Major Organizations

PNU Library originally was located in a school building in Daeshin-dong by 1959, while also using temporary buildings in Jangjeon-dong before constructing the university's first stand-alone facility in 1966. At that time, the library had excellent facilities, such as a reading room that could accommodate 700 students, a reference room, audio-visual rooms, and other amenities. As demand for a larger and more modern library grew, the Central Library (currently SaeByeokBeol Library), approximately 10,578,51m², was built in September 1980 and included reading rooms with a capacity of 2,900. After, PNU's library system expanded as it continued to hold a central position in the university's goal of creating a smart campus, or U-Campus, by constructing in August 2011 the five-floor Library #1 (currently Central Library) on a scale of 7,906m². In addition to the two libraries, there also are several Support·Affiliated Organizations, including the college (graduate school) supporting organization. These organizations are functioning in each position as education facilities and improving the efficacy of university management.

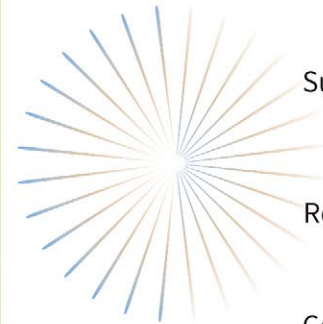

The Library is comprised of six Subject Libraries, including Literature & Arts Library, Humanities & Social Sciences Library, Science & Engineering Library (in the Central Library), the SaeByeokBeol Library (preservation stacks, reading rooms), Law Library in Busan campus, Medical Library in Yangsan campus, Nano & Agricultural Library in Miryang campus.

The Library has a collection consisting of more than 2,500,000 books, more than 70,000 serials (including e-Journals). The Library operates specialized reference and information service rooms such as Rare Books & Archival Collections, iCOMMONS, North Korea Collection, Map Collection, Collection for job information, Foreign Research Information Center, and various specialized collections including UN/EU/IMF Collection, Sheet Music Archives, Bibliotherapy Collection.

The Library aims to provide customized services to specific needs including information service for research and learning activity, user instruction service, SCI analysis service, subject 'Libguide' for departments, and manage reading culture program such as bibliotherapy program, public reading program, lecture of writers.



Office of Information Technology & Services

Office of Information Technology & Services (OITS) provides services for planning, coordination, and management of academic information systems and information assets. In addition, OITS develops and maintains information systems, and provides information security and personal information protection services. Maintenance of classrooms including computational laboratories and rents of practice related equipments, and all other infor-

mation related tasks are also handled in OITS. OITS is running the SMART PNU Students Total Care System and the Online Certificate Issuance System, allowing students to access information conveniently anytime, anywhere using an application on their phone or the web. OITS is also providing U-PIP and PIP to help administrative tasks such as operating organization/faculty members' homepage for education and research purposes and offering server management, web-mail and Internet disk services. In addition it is also operating e-reading rooms, high-tech classrooms, and Cloud-based laboratories. Other important role for the OITS is operating a Information Security Community Center, offering information and personal information security educations to institutes located in the Yeongnam region.

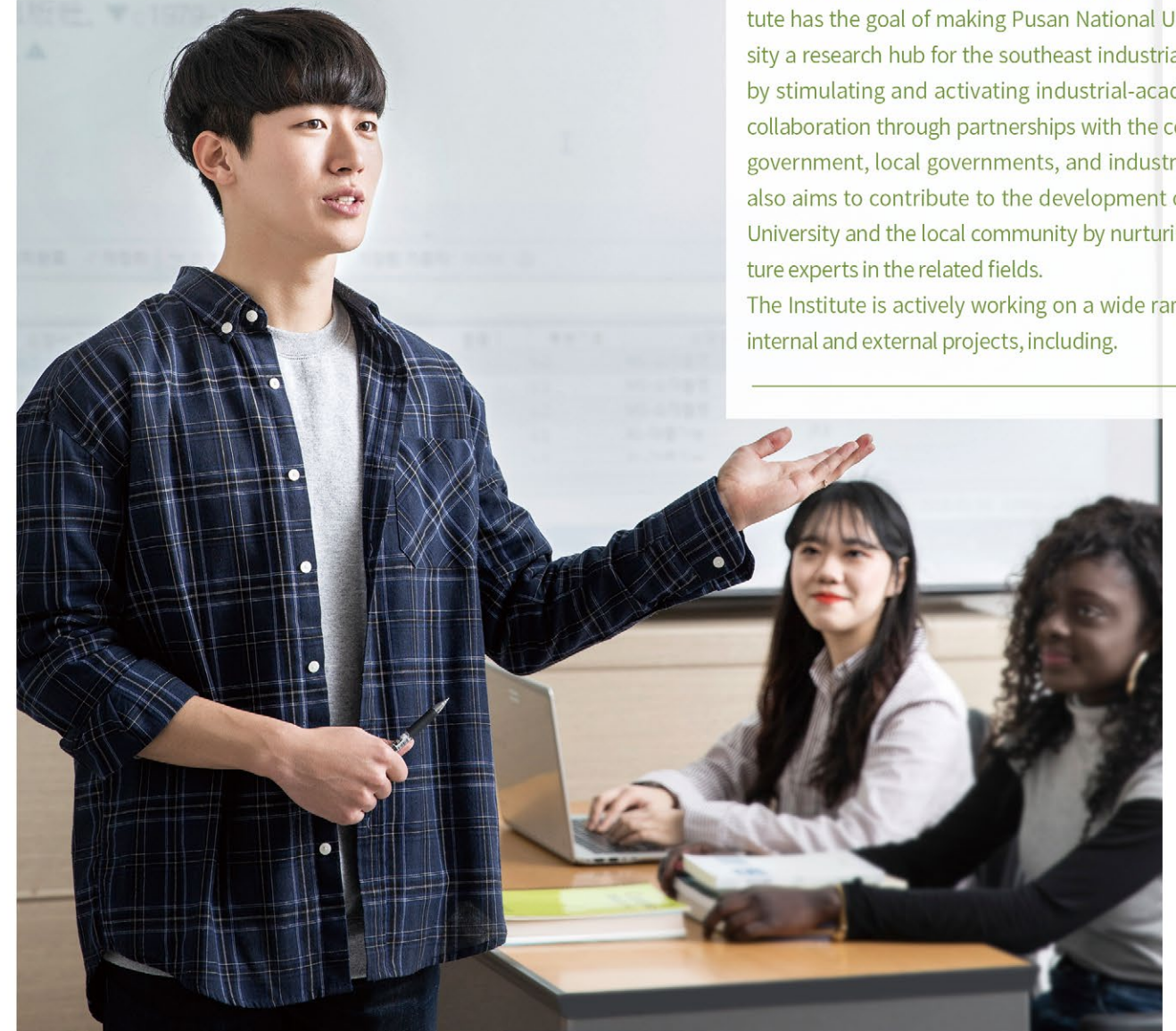

Global Studies Program (GSP)

The Department of Global Studies (DGS), which is part of the College of Economics and International Trade, has developed a second major called the Global Studies Program in 2009. The curriculum, entirely taught in English, uniquely combines the lofty (art, literature, and philosophy), the practical (communication and debate), and the globalized (economics, law, foreign relations, business, and culture).



Korean and East Asian Studies Program (KEASP)

The Department of Global Studies (DGS), which is part of the College of Economics and International Trade, has developed a second major called the Korean and East Asian Studies Program or KEASP. Established in 2014, KEASP is a unique Korean and regional studies program with all courses taught in English by a western-trained faculty. KEASP is an undergraduate program which provides international and Korean students with a diverse education in the cultural, social, political, economic, trade, business and security issues found in this dynamic and ever more important region.

Korean Language Courses

PNU offers four sessions of Korean Language Courses for international students with different levels. Each session is ten weeks long and the curriculum covers Korean tradition, contemporary pop culture. From the courses, students not only learn the language but also gain understanding of Korean culture. Our teachers are experienced, professionally trained instructors in teaching Korean as a foreign language and have a deep understanding of Korean culture. They are dedicated to providing students with excellent classroom instruction.

The courses are organized to develop speaking, listening, reading, and writing skills while aiming at the overall, balanced progress of the four fields. The program also guides students to better understand Korea and its culture. Students are placed at an appropriate level depending on their competence.



PNU Summer School

The PNU Summer School provides foreign students with an enriching cultural and educational experience for two or four weeks.

The program consists of academic courses and various cultural activities such as Taekwondo (traditional martial art), making Korean food, making pottery, learning K-pop dance and temple stay program.

It is divided into two non-overlapping sessions that share common features. Students can choose one according to their schedule, preferences and academic goals.

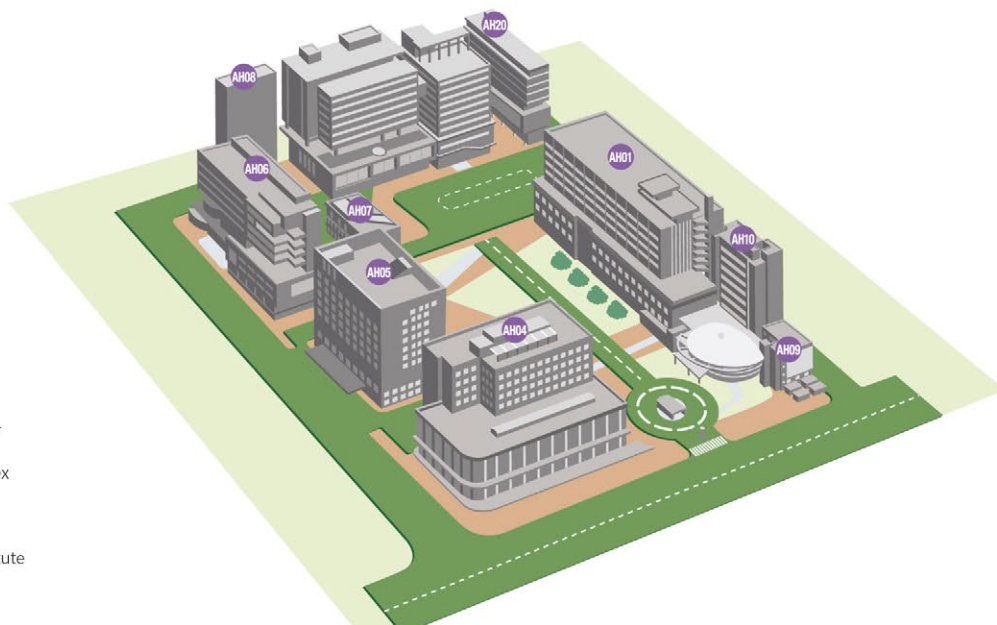
