



UNIVERSITAT DE BARCELONA

The University of Barcelona, founded in the year 1450, has a demonstrably dynamic, critical, constructive and humanist character that places it alongside the leading centres of education, science and critical thought in Spain and the world.

This prestige is reflected in the size of the student community, which numbers around 65.000, and in the demand for places, which regularly exceeds availability. As a generalist university, the UB offers quality teaching across each of the principal branches of knowledge: humanities, health sciences. social sciences, experimental sciences and engineering. In the academic year 2014-2015, students were distributed across 67 bachelor's degrees, 141 university master's degrees, 48 doctoral programmes, over 700 postgraduate courses and some 400 on-site and distance lifelong learning courses, in addition to a selection of massive open online courses, or MOOCs.

In the area of research, the UB has opened its new Humanities and Social Science Park and coordinates the Spanish node of EIT Health, the European Institute of Knowledge and Technology's knowledge and innovation community (KIC) for healthy living and active ageing, which aims to strengthen the work of the HUBc health sciences campus.

These actions, together with participation in networks such as the League of European Research Universities (LERU), the coordination of the Arab-Euro Conference on Higher Education (AECHE), and the creation of strategic alliances with partners including the University of Montpellier and the Complutense University of Madrid, consolidate institutional policies on research, teaching quality, knowledge transfer and internationalization. The combination of these factors has enabled the UB to maintain its position among the highest-placed Spanish universities in major international rankings.

The figures presented here summarize the UB's actions and activities over the last academic year in the areas of teaching, research, innovation, internationalization and mobility.










