The University of Alcalá (UAH), justly considered one of Europe's oldest, may trace its origins to the "General Study" (Studium Generale) created on 20 May 1293. In 1499, Cardinal Cisneros gave a new impulse to that institution by founding a "Greater" College (Colegio Mayor), from which point the University of Alcalá became one of the world's first university cities. It was declared World Heritage Site in 1998.

With a clear international vocation, the UAH is one of the most prestigious public universities in Spain. The UAH is widely recognised for its role in defending and strengthening Spanish language and culture, and the Cervantes Prize, considered the most prestigious prize in Spanish literature, is awarded annually in its auditorium.

Forming an integral part of the city of Alcalá de Henares, University of Alcalá is located 30 kilometres from Madrid and 20 kilometres from the Madrid-Barajas airport.

THE UAH: A WORLD HERITAGE SITE UNIVERSITY

- The University of Alcalá was declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1998, and is one of five universities in the world to boast this title.
- Considered one of the oldest universities in Europe, it can trace its origin to the "General Study" (Studium Generale) established on 20 May 1293. Its constitutional regulations and foundation as a university city, once served as a model for the subsequent creation of future European and Latin American universities.

THE UAH AND ITS HUMANIST HERITAGE

- Distinguished students and teachers, including Cardinal Cisneros, Saint Thomas de Villanueva, Saint Ignacio de Loyola, Elio Antonio de Nebrija, Tirso de Molina, Lope de Vega, Quevedo, Calderón de la Barca or Jovellanos, all once studied in its classrooms.
- The Polyglot Bible was published at the University of Alcalá (1514-1517).
- The Cervantes Prize is awarded every 23 April at its historic "Paraninfo" assembly hall.

OFFICIAL POSTGRADUATE STUDIES

MASTER'S STUDIES

They are official degree programs whose purpose is the acquisition of advanced training oriented to academic/professional specialization or to initiate the student in research.



HOW I ONG DO THEY TAKE?

They range from 60 to 120 ECTS credits (between one and two full academic years)

WHICH ORIENTATIONS DO MASTER'S PROGRAMS OFFER?

Official Master's programmes can have any of the following three orientations:



- **Professional**: training for professional practice.
- **Research**: research activity to prepare students who wish to continue on to doctoral studies
- Academic: training both for professional practice and advanced research.

Most of our Master's degrees involve collaboration with external institutions or companies, and include internships which help students specialise in the orientation that best fits their wants and needs.



HOW MUCH DO THEY COST?

The regional government of Madrid sets the price of Master's degrees by the beginning of each academic year.



WHAT DEGREE WILL I EARN?

Completing these programmes entitles the student to an official Master's Degree, valid throughout Europe.

PHD PROGRAMMES

Their aim is to train students in research techniques. The Doctoral Degree is the highest possible academic degree, and involves the authorship of a work of original research, known as the Doctoral Dissertation.

- All Doctoral Programmes comprise a training period and a research period.
 - Training Period: most Doctoral Programmes offered at UAH equate the training period with a Master's Degree.
 - Research Period: this involves the authorship of a doctoral dissertation. During
 this period the student will be provided academic supervision and access to the
 resources needed for carrying out research along with all the rights accorded to
 Doctoral students.


