Submission	<p>AdventureLearn is a gamified micro-learning platform specifically developed for freshmen with the aim of helping their transition to university learning.</p> <p>It aims to develop them in four key area's or "learning traits", which researchers have identified as crucial for effective learning to take place. These are Approaches to Learning & Studying, Well-Being, Grit & Resilience, and Mindset.</p> <p>By introducing this platform to all freshmen, we target a group of potentially at-risk students for early intervention, allowing them to pick up effective approaches to learning and good habits for well-being from the start of their university journey.</p> <p>More than 100 curated resources have undergone a rigorous process of inter-rater reliability for quality and relevance. There are mini quizzes for knowledge checks, and the platform also utilizes meaningful gamification where visualization of their progress can be seen; rewards are provided to encourage participation.</p>
